I went on to play in college as a libero for The University of Tennessee. During my career at UT, my team won the SEC championship in 2011, and had 3 NCAA tournament appearances from 2010-2012. I was chosen to be a part of the 2013 USAV A2 National Team, competing at the USA Volleyball National Championship in Dallas, TX where I gained valuable experience.

Top Volleyball Highlights: Father Ryan honored my playing career by retiring my jersey on September 18th, 2014. At the University of Tennessee, I was awarded the following: 7-time SEC Defensive Player of the Week, 2-time All-Southern region and 2- time AVCA All American awards. I set the all-time career dig record at Tennessee with 1,801 digs, which ranks fourth all time in the Southeastern Conference.
