## September 2025 MONTHLY MEETING

Meeting Called to Order: 9:25 PM

- August meeting minutes were approved

President's Report: Gallucci

- Very pleased to see great interest from new people for the board.

VP On-Field: Seapker

- Full Year Teams have been selected
  - Assessments and subsequent selections went very well
  - Coach Selection and Team Selections were completed
    - 10U – 2 teams
      - 10U White Coach needs to be selected
      - Jim Margeson volunteered [Shiple/Sleasman]
  - Teams are starting to meet/practice
  - Plans for teams/fundraising need to be transparent and communicated to parents on the teams
  - All team budgets will be tracked and visible to AAA Board, including registration fees and any fundraising

- Teams will be permitted to solicit individual contributions, but sponsorships will be to AAA organizations, not to specific teams.
- Spring tournaments for AAA Tournament Teams were discussed.
  - Spring In-House is still priority
  - Teams are encouraged to play one day Sunday tournaments if possible
- Fall Season Started on Sept 6
  - Team drafts went very well
  - All leagues have started.
    - QV elected not to play Fall ML.
    - No issues or complaints so far

#### Financial Report: Waters

  - Money for new tractor at PONY Field was received, and tractor has been purchased and delivered.

#### VP Off-Field: Gilbert

- Fall "Clearance" Sale will be planned- 9/27 or 10/11.
  - Targeting 9/27, weather and availability dependent.
- Napoli Hoagie sale will be planned for another weekend this fall.

#### Field Maintenance: Shipley

- Field Materials are good for now, but will need to be reordered soon
- LL mound was rebuilt
- All fields are in great shape
- Still waiting on Pittsburgh Pirates grant for PONY Field renovations. PONY field renovations will start, with help from Avonworth School District.
- Fall Clean up scheduled for October 25, with the ability to push to November if a travel tournament is scheduled.

#### Clearances: Brown

- 98% of coaches clearances are submitted, 91% of LL Abuse Training.
- New Clearances will be reset for 2026 on October 1.
- Travel Team Coaches are 100%
- LL Abuse Training is required annually

#### Concession Stand: Gallucci

- Opened for fall ball
- First Saturday raised \$1,400
- Fall To Date
  - \$1,659 income, \$754 in expenses
  - Net Income= \$1,445

#### Umpires: Jamison

- New Contract will require organization to pay for umpires for "non-weather" related cancellations.

#### Equipment: Mangene (report by others)

- Some new baseballs were ordered
- Fall Ball buckets and gear are out to the Fall coaches.
- New Tees will be needed for spring. Will look into tee repairs rather than replacement.

#### Uniforms: Milsom

- Fall uniforms have been ordered, should arrive next week
- Full year team uniforms still have time to be ordered.
  - Full year team uniforms will be slightly more than last year for better quality options.
  - Uniform budget (two jerseys and one hat) to be no more than \$115 [Ludwig/Berneberg]. Uniforms will be designed and ordered.
  - Additional uniform costs (pants, bags, etc) would be ordered by teams
