- September meeting minutes were approved

President's Report: Gallucci

- Dave Gregory, head of umpires for PUA attended the meeting to discuss the new umpire contract. (vote took place during "umpires" portion later in the meeting).
 - Proposed changes to contract between AAA and PUA:
 - Increase scheduling fee from \$3 to \$3.25 per game.
 - Non-weather cancellations within 48 hours of game time will result in AAA being charged the full fee for umpire(s).
- Future Board Meetings will be held the 2nd Thursday of the month. Will be posted on the public calendar on the website.
- Board attendance has varied from 30% to 100% over last year among current Board members. The President stressed the importance of attendance and requested that members attend as many as possible.
