

CSL Player Practice Drop off Policy:

- 1. All teams will have a communication thread and parents are expected to be attentive to this thread during practices/games.
- 2. Parents/guardians who know their child has special needs should stay by their child's field during practice and the game in case of incidence where their child's immediate need is best served by the parent or guardian. Examples include, but not limited to the use of EpiPen, extreme asthmatic conditions, emotional outbursts, any other known physical conditions, etc.
- 3. Parents/guardians of **age 11 and below** are required to stay on the CSL soccer complex for the entire practice or game. CSL requests that parents/guardians stay within eyes and ears of their child's practice field during the entire practice day/time.
- 4. Parents/guardians of **age 12 and above** may leave the complex but are asked to communicate on the team communication thread the name and contact information of the person who has assumed responsibility for their child (in case of injury, incidence, and pick-up) by the <u>beginning</u> of practice/game time. That person should be no farther than 3 miles away so that a timely return can be made if needed.
- 5. Unfortunately, if a child is not picked up within **15 minutes** of scheduled end of practice/game <u>and</u> no communication has been received on the team communication thread, CSL must assume something has happened to prevent the parent/guardian from being able to pick up their child and therefore CSL will contact the Portsmouth Police Department to help us care for the child until the parent is able.
