Payment Options

Option 1: Pay in Full upon Registration

Option 2: \$150 Commitment fee upon Registration - Balance due in full by July 15, 2016.

Option 3: \$150 Commitment fee upon Registration – Balance due in 3 equal installments due July 15, September 15, and November 15, 2016

Option 4: \$150 Commitment Fee upon Registration – Balance due in 7 equal monthly installments due on the fifteenth of July, August, September, October, November, December 2016 and January 2017.

What Do Your Fees Cover?

- Player registration fee to the Florida Youth Soccer Association (and U.S. Club Soccer for NPL players) providing membership to the governing bodies for program administration and insurance.
- Team registration fees for leagues such as BYSL, GCF, and SSL and referee fees for regular league play.
- Operational and administrative costs such as field and equipment maintenance, lighting, administrative support, accounting, scheduling, office supplies, marketing, etc. We are committed to maintaining a safe playing environment and ensuring best business practices for the organization.
- Equipment such as goals, balls, cones, pinnies, nets, etc.
- Licensed and experienced coaching and training staff. The quality of the staff has perhaps the strongest impact on the development of the players' skills and their enjoyment of the game. Space Coast United understands coaching at this level is a licensed profession and takes the legal and ethical obligation of being a fair employer seriously.
- Seminars and town hall meetings for parents throughout the year on subjects relevant to player development.

Volunteerism

Space Coast United Soccer club is a non-profit organization dedicated to controlling costs to our members and therefore dependent upon volunteers to assist the Club in support of our programming.

We encourage each player and his/her family to help us keep costs down through volunteerism. Opportunities for service hours are varied and on-going, published regularly at VolunteerSpot.com which can be accessed from the club's website. Teenagers are eligible for Bright Futures community service hours and should make the appropriate arrangements with their guidance counselor.

Academy/Competitive Uniform Cost

Our uniform style remains the same for this season. Returning players will only need to order replacement pieces necessary because of growth or wear and tear. Payment is made when ordering on soccer.com.

Team managers coordinate with parents to determine jersey numbers and forward that information to our Uniform Coordinator. Soccer.com sends an email to the parents when the link to order is active. Please order any uniform pieces needed as soon as possible. It can take up to three weeks for customization and delivery.

** We recommend two training jerseys as players wear them to every practice.*

Team Expenses

We do not bundle team expenses with registration and training fees because experience has demonstrated that type of fee structure places an unfair burden on families with players on teams competing in fewer or less expensive events than teams that participate in more tournaments and elite events out-of-state. Space Coast United Soccer Club does work with our coaching staff to take advantage of economies of scale to minimize team costs, but trusts our coaches to decide which events align best with their team's stage of competitive development.

Therefore, in addition to the fees explained above, the members of each team are responsible for sharing the costs of team-specific expenses such as tournament registration fees, non-league referee fees (for example: scrimmages officiated by certified referees), coach travel expenses for out-of-county games and tournaments, etc.

As team expenses are entirely dependent upon the age group and level of play, especially with respect to the number, type, and location of tournaments, parents are encouraged to contact the coach and/or team manager to request a projected team budget for the year if one has not already been provided for them.

Each family is responsible for their own travel expenses associated with team commitments.

The Club supports teams by promoting their fundraising events on social media to assist them in offsetting their team-specific expenses, thereby lowering direct costs to the families.
