

WHAT WILL IT COST?

- Registration Fee: K-3 Grade \$85 / 4-6 Grade \$105
- Uniforms cost between \$200-\$400, depending on optional selections and availability of used uniform pieces
- Cheer Dues: Estimated \$75 helps pay for practice facilities (this is a one-time fee each year)

FUNDRAISING

- Fundraising can be used for uniform costs and other costs throughout the season
- Individual Fundraisers: Trash bags (40% profit)
- Area Fundraisers: There will be other fundraising opportunities through out the season to help with costs (practice facilities, squad fees, etc.)
- Scholarships available through the KCFC website

TIME COMMITMENT??
