CODE OF CONDUCT

South Beaches Little League (SBLL) is a recreational league with the goal of promoting a positive atmosphere for players to learn and practice the skills of baseball. Everyone involved in the league does so, on a volunteer basis including the board of directors, coaches and umpires.

It is the responsibility of every player, parent, fan and coach to treat each other with respect and courtesy. There is no place for rude or abusive actions by an individual participating in a SBLL event including both practices and games. Any loud or demeaning verbal abuse will not be tolerated from anyone.

During games, the umpires are in charge of the game. Any reports of physical or verbal abuse will be investigated by the board and will result in penalties up to and including expulsion from the league.

Parents: Do not get into an argument or discussion with any umpires at any time. Spectators that make comments about calls to an umpire or continually criticize umpire calls may be asked to leave the field. Only a coach should approach and speak with an umpire.

Coaches: If you have any questions about a call that is made by an umpire, you are expected to walk to the umpire who made the call, speak politely with the umpire, and allow that umpire to discuss the call with any other umpires working the game with them. All decisions made by the umpires must be accepted as the final decision.

Any violations of this "Code of Conduct" will result in a minimum of a 1 game suspension and a review of the incident by the board of directors. After review, the board may lay a heavier penalty to include being removed from that position for 20 games or the remainder of the season, whichever is longer.

Remember, the purpose of this league is to support a positive recreational environment and it is **For the Kids**. Let's have fun and Play Ball!
