



Minor A Baseball Special Rules

- Per LL Regulation VIII(b), Canal LL establishes a policy that parents of players League Age 10 and 11 may elect to withhold their players from the Majors Draft. These players will play in the Minor A Division.
- The inning is over when the offensive team records three (3) outs or has scored four (4) runs.
- When a home run or ground rule double occurs that exceeds the run limit, the play continues with runners advancing until the play is completed. When the play has been completed, that side of the inning is over. Any runs that exceed the four (4) runs will count.
- Unlimited runs in the 6th inning or last inning as designated by the umpire(s).
- There will be a two-hour time limit on all games that have another game scheduled on the same field within 45 minutes of the scheduled end of the game. Once the two-hour time limit is hit, the inning being played may be completed. (LL Regulation VII(h)) Regular season games may end in a tie.
- If the designated catcher is on base with 2 outs a substitute runner (the player that made the previous out) is permitted for the catcher. This will give the catcher the necessary time needed to get his/her gear on.
- Batter is out on a dropped third strike. ○ After entering the batter's box, the batter must remain in the box with at least one foot throughout the at bat. See Little League Rule 6.02(c) for exceptions.
- All teams will make the playoffs, which will be single elimination format, seeding based on final regular season standings. Standings will be based on team's won-loss-tie percentage, and tie breakers among tied teams are, in order: won-loss-tie percentage, head-to-head, runs allowed, runs scored, coin flip. If a team leads by 5 runs or more, they are no longer permitted to steal home. Once the run differential falls below 5 runs, they are once again permitted to steal home.
