



2019 SPRING SEASON - INFORMATION

- ONLINE REGISTRATION IS NOW AVAILABLE – walk up paper registration is no longer offered
- If you are on Facebook, please go to our Chino Hills Little League Facebook page and click “Like”. Any and all league communication, including important calendar events will be available to you.
- Teams will be put together on February 2nd. Field practices will begin the week of February 4th.
- The spring season will begin on March 2 and will end in June for most divisions. The season is 13 weeks.
- Most divisions will have two games per week. Games are scheduled one week day and on Saturday. In some instances we may be forced to schedule a Sunday game but this is very rare.
- Depending on the division size, certain divisions may interlock with other local leagues in our district. Upper Division Interlock teams may have to travel to other local leagues for games.
- Most divisions will have two practices per week. One for field practice and one for batting practice. The number of practices will be determined by each teams Manager and Coaches.
- Players League age 9 and above must participate in the spring season draft tryouts. Teams are formed based on Manager Draft selections.
- Players League age 8 and younger will be placed on teams based on age and previous playing experience. Parent special requests are considered for same age siblings.
- For the spring season, registration covers league entry, player hat, and jersey. Parents are responsible for purchasing your child’s pants, socks, belt, athletic supporter, cleats and any other baseball equipment you may decide to purchase (bats, helmets, and glove).
 - Pricing for pants range from \$20.00 and up based on style, manufacturer. Color will be determined by which team your player is assigned.
 - Cleats range from \$25.00 and up depending on style and manufacturer
- Makeup games due to weather will be scheduled based on the CH Park and Recs field allocations schedule.
- The league will provide helmets for each team; however it is strongly encouraged that you purchase your own batting helmet specifically for your child. Purchased helmets must meet the Little League safety standards. Look for the Little League approved USA Baseball Standard logo before purchasing any baseball equipment.

- Saturday, January 12th – January 19th - spring walk up registration events take place Saturday 9am – 12pm at Albertson’s located on the corner of Soquel Canyon and Butterfield Ranch Road.
- Saturday, January 26th – **FINAL** spring registration event – Chino Hills Community Park – late registration \$25 fee applies after this date.
- Saturday, January 26th – Spring Season Upper Division Assessment – League age 9 and above must complete assessments to be placed on a team.
- Wednesday, January 30th – Makeup Tryouts and Registration Waitlist begins. Cannot guarantee player name or preferred number on Jersey.
- Friday, February 1st – Players Draft – Managers Mandatory attendance
- Saturday, February 2nd – Teams and Managers announced
- Monday, February 4th – team practice schedule begins
- Saturday, March 2nd – Opening Day Event
- Friday, May 31st – spring regular season ends
- Saturday, June 2nd – Spring Post “TOC” Tournament and CHLL AllStar season begins – upper divisions only
