



2026 Volunteer Code of Conduct

Thank you for volunteering your time, knowledge, and commitment to the players and organization. The following rules are set forth for your eligibility this season to abide by per the SCLL Board of Directors:

1. I will strive to make baseball fun and enjoyable for all players and spectators in attendance for all SCLL events. I will promote the game of baseball and SCLL in a positive manner, always!
2. I will not criticize players, umpires or coaches in front of other players or spectators inappropriately.
3. I will strive to concentrate on the development of players, safety of all players, promote good sportsmanship, and properly educate each player on becoming more knowledgeable of the game of baseball.
4. I will accept decisions of umpires as being fair and called to the best of their ability. Baseball is a game of interpretations, and as a result disputes will occur from time to time – I will conduct professional and courteous discussions with the umpires and coaches to resolve conflict respectfully.
5. I will refrain from arguing and/or offensive touching any player, manager, coach or umpire within SCLL. SCLL has a “zero-tolerance” policy for any aggressive, abusive, or inappropriate physical contact with a player, coach, umpire or spectator.
6. I will treat all volunteers of SCLL with the utmost respect. I will refrain from communicating negative views of the SCLL within the facility and via social media. This includes players, parents, coaches, managers, the SCLL Board of Directors as a whole, individual board members, umpires, and all other volunteers for SCLL.
7. I will not use profanity or bad language in the presence of players while at practice or at the SCLL facility.
8. I will not permit athletes to utilize illegal equipment or gain momentum by other means of winning outside of the Little League handbook.
9. It is my responsibility to encourage all players, parents, and family members to attend Opening Day Ceremonies, Allocated Team Picture Times, Concession Duties and to promote the organization in a positive manner. I will attend all required Safety Meetings, Coaches Meetings, and delegate in my absence.
10. I will follow all rules of eligibility for players within the league and will concentrate on the safety of the players for every practice and game.
11. I will communicate all practice, game, concession, and pertinent schedules in a timely manner to all participants of my team as advised by the SCLL Board of Directors.
12. I will not tolerate the use or possession of alcohol, tobacco, or illicit substances by myself or anyone at practice, games or at the SCLL facility. Additionally, I will not permit or tolerate any person to interact with the players with suspicion of an individual under the influence.
13. I recognize that each month there are Board Meetings that I can attend to professionally address any issues that have not been resolved through proper channels of command. Proper Channels Include: Addressing the Team Manager, Team Manager to Division Director, Division Director to Executive Board, Executive Board to SCLL Board.
14. I will always make sure that the field of play is safe prior to holding a practice or game, and I will make sure the weather conditions have not disrupted future use of the field.

By signing the SCLL 2026 Code of Conduct, I acknowledge the rules set forth. I am aware these set rules determine my eligibility to volunteer this season, and future seasons.
