



### **Heads Up Concussion Test and Information**

Some of you may or may not know of the new State of Michigan Law; Public Acts 342 and 343.

This law pertains to concussion awareness for coaches and will go into effect on JUNE 30, 2013. Per the state community health department (517-335-9518), anyone who coaches kids in the state of Michigan will fall under this new law. This means that everyone who is responsible for coaching MUST go online and take the test. If a player was to get hurt and you have not done so, it would be considered neglect and you would be in violation of state law.
