



DICK's Game Changer/Team Manager App

1. On your phone, go to the app store and search “Dicks game changer”. You will want to download the first one that pops up. A sample picture is shown above.
2. Once the download is complete, you will log in using the same log in and password that you used to register your child through Countryside Little League.
3. After you log in, you will click the plus sign in the upper right-hand corner, and the app will automatically search for your team. You do not have to create your team. If your team does not show up automatically, sometimes it's just a matter of a board member un-posting and then reposting your roster.
4. You now have access to your team in the app. Here are some features you can use in the app.

I. Settings – Click the gear in the upper right corner

- a. Team Info
 - i. You can add a team photo/logo if you like
 - ii. Team Info – You can rename your team if you like. I've never changed this though in fear of it not syncing to our schedule.
- b. Stat Settings & Game Alerts – Not useful if you aren't scoring games
- c. Schedule Sync – This is another way to refresh your schedule
- d. Practice Scoring a Game – you can obviously practice scoring a game if you want to see how it works. If you want to score games through the app, see the Step V below.

II. Bottom Bar: Teams – Click on your team

- a. Message Team
 - i. Right under you team name and record, you can send a Message to your entire team. You can send it as a Team Chat which is kind of like Facebook Messenger or you can send the message via Email.
- b. Schedule
 - i. Schedule is listed below. Changes don't always show up right away. You can try using Schedule Sync which was discussed above.
 - ii. If you touch on an event you can RSVP to the event for yourself and for your child. There is also a Health Status Tracker that you can use if you like.
 - iii. Player RSVP – If you click this, you can RSVP for your entire team or parents can RSVP for their child. I like to go through and RVSP “Going” for all of my team. I do this myself because I know that I will never get 100% of the parents to RSVP. Then if a parent lets me know their child can't make it to that event, I just can change it to “Not Going”. This helps when a parents tells me my kids can be there on a certain date in the future.
 - iv. Staff/Family RSVP – I don't use this much but Asst Coaches and parents can RSVP to the practice as well.
 - v. If you scroll down further, you can see the field location of the event, address and map to the event and a weather report for the time of the event.
- c. Team
 - i. Here is where you can see a list of Staff and Players

ii. If there is an exclamation point on their icon, this means they are not using the app. If you touch on the person's name, you can then click "Resend Invite" to remind them to download and use the app. You can also see their contact information and who they are linked to as a player or staff.

iii. If you click on a player, you can then click Edit on the top right corner. Here you can add a picture and the player's jersey number. Don't bother trying to update the Bats and Throws category because these won't save. You can also add a parent email or remove the player from your team. d. Video, Stats, Opponents – Not much to say here, pretty straight forward

III. Bottom Bar: Events

a. You can see a list of all upcoming events. If you have multiple teams, you can see all the events for both of your teams. You can also RSVP from this schedule as well.

IV. Bottom Bar – Messages

a. This is another place where you can send message to your team via Chat

V. Bottom Bar – Profile

a. You can add a picture for yourself or change your password
