PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

- 1. I will make every effort to attend practice and scheduled games.
- 2. I will participate in all drills and skill development activities to the best of my ability during practices, knowing that my coaches will consider my efforts during practice when deciding who will play in each game.
- 3. I will follow and respect my coaches' instructions, rules, and regulations during practices/games.
- 4. I will exhibit good sportsmanship at all times by:
 - a. Demonstrating positive support for all teammates, coaches, officials, and opponents.
 - b. Showing appreciation for an outstanding play by either team.
 - c. Accepting the decisions of officials without complaining.
 - d. Refraining from booing, taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language.
- 5. While not in the game, I will be on the bench supporting my team.
- 6. I will be a team player and give 100% at all times.
- 7. I will acknowledge that sometimes learning is more important that winning.
- 8. And most importantly, I will have fun!
