

LWLL Bylaws

UNIFORMS

All divisions shall receive a hat (BB)/Headband (SB), jersey and socks
Players shall provide their own grey pants (baseball)/black pants (Softball) and
belt.

Shirts must be always tucked in. If the pants have a belt loop, a belt is required
and needs to match jersey or socks. Hats must be always worn in the proper
manner. Dress code will be strictly enforced. Managers and coaches must abide by
the dress code as well.

GAME CURFEW

Senior Baseball – 1 hour 45 minutes, finish the inning
Major Baseball – 1 hour 30 minutes, finish the inning
Minor Baseball/Softball & Major Softball & Senior Softball – 1 hour 30 minutes,
finish the inning
Mini-Minor Baseball and Softball – 1 hour 15 minutes, finish the inning
4-5 T-ball/6 yr old Coach Pitch – 1 hour, finish the inning

5 RUN RULE

There is a 5 run rule for minor divisions per inning. (7-10 year olds)

ALL STAR SELECTION

Managers select the top 9 players first and then a manager. This is done by way of
round table discussion. The chosen manager will make the final selection of 3 or
more players, depending on how many players he chooses to take. 12 players is
the minimum. The manager also selects his assistant coaches. The selected
assistant coaches must be from that division of managers and coaches.

CITY CHAMPION TIE BREAKERS

There will be no playoff games – the first place team for the entire season will be named champion. If a tie breaker is needed it will be determined as follows:

2-way tie – head to head first – 1 game play off

3-way tie – head to head first – draw #'s for bye seed, then playoff game. The winning team plays bye seed.

Only 1 pool player per team allowed per the entire tourney.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Any disciplinary action regarding a player shall be submitted in writing to the respective VP and documentation will be required for tardiness, poor attendance to practices, arriving late for games, poor or disruptive attitudes, etc.... No disciplinary action can take place without proper documentation.

CONTINUOUS BATTING ORDER

All divisions will have a continuous batting order. Due to problems enforcing the substitutions rule 3.03, there will be continuous batting order and free defensive substitutions except for pitchers.

MANDATORY PLAY RULE

Regulation IV(i) – Every player on the team roster will participate in each game for a minimum of 6 defensive outs and 1 at bat.

Penalties for Head Coach:

1st offense – written warning

2nd offense – suspension for next game

3rd offense – suspension for remainder of season

When an game ends early (due to run rule) and a player has not played their minimum defensive outs and at bat, that player is to start in the next game

EJECTIONS

Player: In the event a player is ejected during a game, that player shall immediately be escorted to the parents (if available) and must leave the complex or to the press box where he/she will remain until a guardian arrives. They will then sit out their next scheduled game (in uniform) on the bench, in the dugout. They shall not be allowed to be a base coach or come on the field for any reason until completion of the disciplinary game. The player may not play again until they serve their suspended game.

Manager/Coach: If a manager or coach is ejected during a game, they shall immediately leave the premises of the complex. They will then be contacted by their VP for further disciplinary action including but not limited to suspension from the next scheduled game or expulsion from the league. In both cases, should the ejection occur in the final game of the season, they shall serve their disciplinary action the following season.

Parents / Spectators: If a parent violates the Parent/Guardian code of conduct signed at the beginning of the season they will face the penalties listed in the code of conduct. Spectators who violate the LWLL zero-tolerance policy they will be subject to the same disciplinary actions listed in the code of conduct BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

If you are Ejected from a game and escorted to the edge of the property outside of the gate, due to a breach of the Code of Conduct, you will be immediately trespassed. Even if you have a player in the game. You will have to watch your player from the outside of the fence until you are able to complete an Anger Management course and turn in the certification to the BOD via email and await a call to allow your presence at the following game. We must work together!
