AGE DETERMINATION

Any player eligible to participate in EVLL baseball who is league age 7-12 years old, must attend one of the tryouts to be able to play in the Majors, Minors, or Rookie Divisions.

A player's "league age" is their age as of August 31,2022.

THE DRAFT

By signing up for Little League Baseball you may <u>NOT</u> choose which team, coach, or players you may play with. That final decision is left to the Managers and the local Board of Directors.

PROCESS

The Managers will attend tryouts and evaluate each player. All children attending tryouts will be selected in a draft by a Manager, based on the child's ability to play. If your child is drafted on a Major team, it is because the Manager feels they have the ability to play at that level. The same applies for other divisions. All 10 year olds who are drafted to play in the Major division, will be placed on the Minor All Star Team if approved by the League at the end of the season.

EQUIPMENT

Be on time, bring a glove, cleats, and wear a baseball hat. Please dress for baseball and be ready to catch fly balls, field ground balls, hit the ball, pitch, and run <u>as fast as you can.</u> The Managers will be looking for not only skill, but a proper attitude as well.

CALL UPS

Sometimes the need arises for a Major team to call a player up from one of the lower divisions during the season. If this happens, the Player Agent will call the parents of the child that the Managers wish to draft up. The child cannot, and will not be directly contacted by the Manager of any team for this purpose. The parent will be asked if that child would like to move up. It is a testament to a player's skill level to be asked to move up during the season. The parent and player must notify the Player Agent within 24 hours of their decision. If a player chooses not to move up, they forfeit any chance of being moved up again for the remainder of the season.
