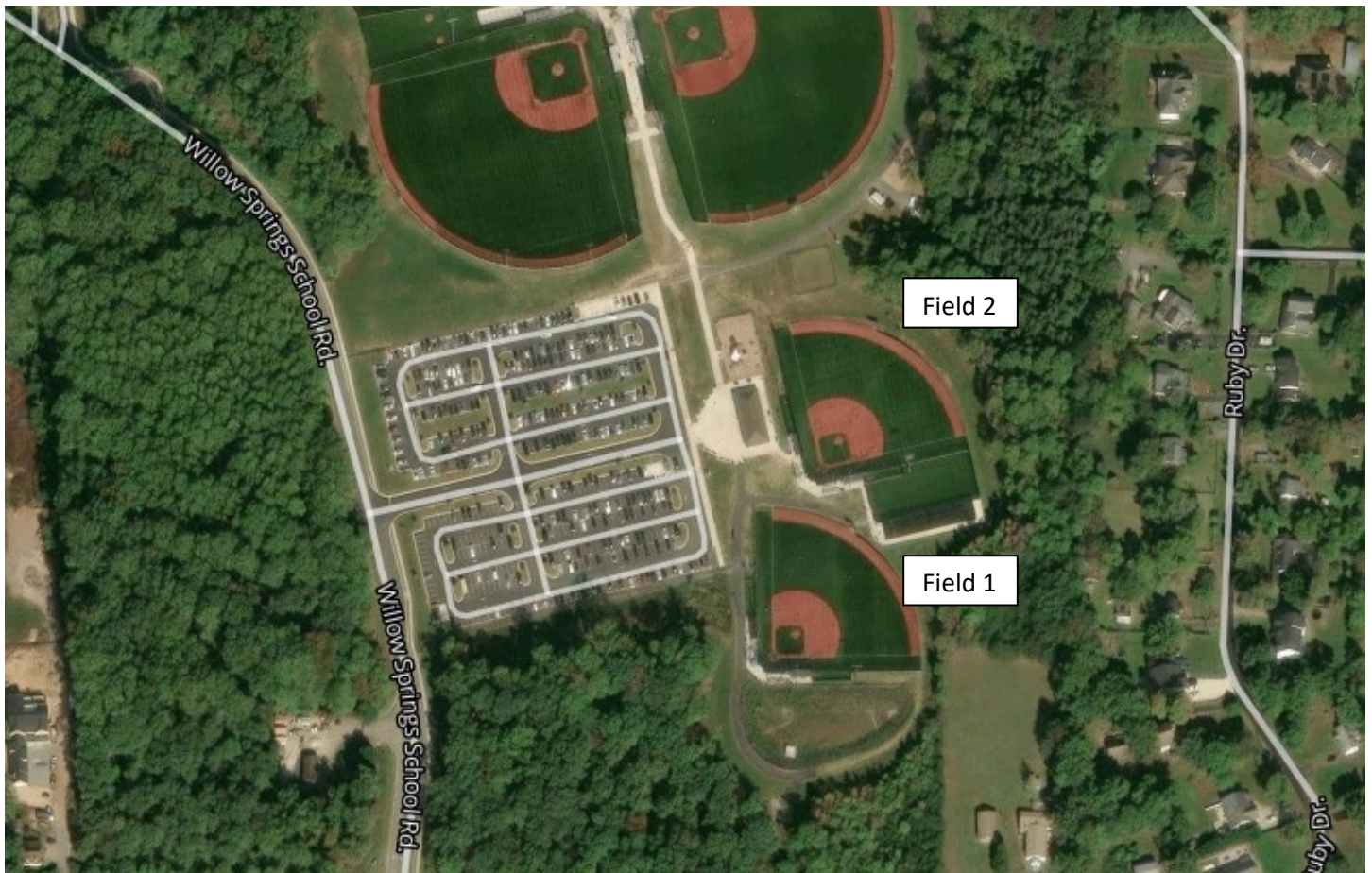

Playing and Practice Fields

All games will be held at Patriot Park North. This location has 2 fields, both fully turfed with portable pitching mounds. Games will be played on both, and the championship game will be played on Field 2.

For a practice field, you must contact Bob Woodruff at 703-851-7457. Practice fields are not turfed and are located throughout the Centreville area.

Admission Fees and Parking

Admission is FREE. Parking for all games will be located at Patriot Park North. Parking is at your own risk. Some of the parking is close to the fields and cars may be subject to being hit with foul balls. There is handicap parking available as marked.

Spectator Policies and Procedures

Bleacher seating is available at the field. There is also limited room for individuals using personal lawn chairs. Please remember to have your fans be conscious of the fact that others will be watching the games, and the use of umbrellas or tents should be limited. We want everyone who comes to have a good time and to cheer for their team and children. We expect no less. However, unruly and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated by anyone in attendance. If a fan becomes unruly, abusive towards the umpires, players, coaching staff, or anyone else, they will be asked to cease their behavior. If they do not, they will be asked to leave the game and if necessary, will be escorted from the ballpark. **No noise makers of any kind may be used per Little League rules.** No tobacco, including vaping, will be allowed within 100 feet of any facilities players could be using (this includes snack shack, batting cages, and bathrooms). Alcoholic beverages will not be allowed. **No equipment associated with parental streaming or recording of games may be affixed to ANY location on the playing facility, including light stanchions and fencing.** If a parent wishes to stream a game, it must be viewed through a personal social media account for private use only and may not be on the open internet.

Game Procedures/Guidelines

All official Little League tournament rules will be strictly enforced throughout the tournament. According to tournament rules, the home team will be determined by the toss of a coin. For all pool games, coin tosses will be conducted at the pre-tournament meeting on Thursday, July 16th. A representative from each team **MUST** be present at this meeting. The tournament director will conduct the coin toss at all elimination games 45 minutes before the scheduled game start time. Each team will have a maximum of 10 minutes of infield/outfield practice before each game. This time may be reduced by weather conditions or if the previous game runs over.

Concession and Vendor Information

There will be a full-service concession stand operating during all games. We will have a pre-order form to order tournament t-shirts for teams. Additional t-shirts will be available throughout the tournament with limited availability.

Team Equipment

Each team will be responsible for providing their own equipment (including practice balls). SYA Little League will have on hand extra batting helmets and catching gear in case of emergencies. There are sporting goods stores in the area. Your team host will be able to provide you with more information. Water will be provided in each dugout during each game. Tournament officials will be around during the games to make sure they stay full.

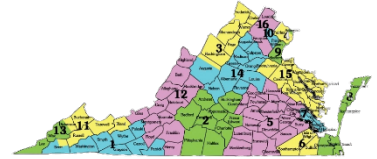
