

## Setting Up Your Team on GameChanger

**Step 1: Download the App** Search for "GameChanger Team Manager" in the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android). Look for the green "GC" logo. Download and install it — it's free.

**Step 2: Create an Account** Open the app and sign up with your email address and a password.

**Step 3: Create Your Team** Tap the "Create New Team" button (or the "+" icon on the Home tab). You'll be asked to fill in some basic details — sport, team name, age group, location, and season. Tap "Finish" when done.

**Step 4: Add Your Players** Once your team is created, go to the Roster section and start adding your players. You'll enter each child's name and can optionally add their jersey number and position. Don't worry about getting everything perfect right away — you can always edit it later.

**Step 5: Invite Parents** After adding a player, you'll have the option to add a parent or guardian's email address. GameChanger will send them an invitation to join the team. Once they accept, they'll be able to see the schedule, get messages, and follow games.

**Step 6: Add Your Schedule** Tap the Schedule tab and add your practices and games. For each event you can include the date, time, location, and even turn on an RSVP feature so you know who's coming.

**Step 7: Message Your Team** Use the Messaging tab to send announcements to all parents at once — great for reminders, cancellations, or any updates during the season.

That's really all there is to it! Once the parents accept their invites, the whole team will be connected and you can manage everything from your phone.

### A few good things to know:

- GameChanger is completely free for coaches. Parents can use the basic features for free too, but some extras (like unlimited live stream viewing) require a paid subscription on their end.
- You can practice scorekeeping in the app before your first game so you feel comfortable with it. Scorekeeping applies to the older divisions as we don't keep score at the younger levels. If you choose to keep score, you can add a parent or other coach as an administrator so that they can do it for you.
