Where will the Yeti practice?

The final site for 2018 is TBD. The Yeti practiced at Northdale Middle School in Coon Rapids in Summer 2017.

When will the Yeti practice?

Yeti practice will begin late May-early June, once the high school season comes to an end. Practice will go through late fall, with a one week break over July 4th (HS non-contact week), and a one month break over the month of August.

Practices will include one week night (TBD) and Sunday late afternoon/early evening.

What tournaments will the Yeti play in?

All tournaments are tentative. But the intent is 2-3 summer full field tournaments and 2 small field tournaments. Additional tournaments may be added based on interest and coach/player availability.

Can my player be on the Yeti and a local association team?

Yes, but we ask that you make decisions about Yeti and association practices as appropriate.

How much will Yeti cost?

Player Fee: \$325 (\$200 due on 10/1/2017, \$125 due on 1/1/2018)

Uniform Fee: \$150, will include light and dark jersey, skirt, and numbered practice pinnie. For returning players, the same uniform kit will be used in 2018.

Tournament Fees: These will vary by tournament, usually between \$50-\$125 (local) to \$350-\$500 (regional). These fees will be due 30 days prior to the first day of each tournament

What happens after the try-out?
