\*A team may submit a single payment for all players. The full payment must be equal to the Registration fee x the number of players/registration forms submitted. You cannot pay for a "spot". We will not accept a registration form without payment. The payment will stay with the child (ex. should a child switch teams within the league the fee stays with them.) If a new child (not registered) joins the team, they must pay the entry fee by the registration deadline.

## LOVE HATBOX SPORTS COMPLEX - PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

**As a parent**, you play a special role in contributing to the needs and development of youngsters. Through your encouragement and good example, you can help assure that all the boys and girls learn good sportsmanship and self-discipline. At Love Hatbox Sports Complex, young people learn to work together, to sacrifice for the good of the team, to enjoy winning and deal appropriately with defeat – all while becoming physically fit and healthy. Best of all, they have fun.

**Support your child** - Supporting your child by giving encouragement and showing interest in their team is very important. Help your child work toward skill improvement and good sportsmanship in every game. Teach your child that hard work and an honest effort are often more important than victory – that way your child will always be a winner despite the outcome of the game!

**Always be positive** - Parents serve as role models for their children. Become aware of this and work to be a positive role model. Applaud good plays by your child's team as well as good plays by the opposing team. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from youth sports activities.

**Remember that your child wants to have fun** - Remember that your child is the one playing, not you. It is very important to let children establish their own goals – to play the game for themselves. Take care not to impose your own standards and goals on them. Don't put too heavy a burden on your child to win games. Children play for the fun of playing.

**Reinforce Positive behavior** - Positive reinforcement is the best way to help your child achieve their goals and their natural fear of failure. Nobody likes to make mistakes. If your child does make one, remember it is all part of learning, so encourage your child's efforts and point out the good things your child accomplished.

**Do not be a sideline coach or umpire** - Coaches and umpires are usually parents just like you. They volunteer time to help make your child's youth experiences a positive one. They need your support too. That means refraining from coaching or umpiring from the sidelines. There is usually always an opportunity for you to take your interest in coaching or umpiring to the next level and become one yourself.

### Parents Pledge:

- I shall set an example for sportsmanship for my child to follow. I shall emphasize team play to my child. I shall show by example respect for umpires/officials, opposing teams and other fans. I shall not be a grandstand manager. I shall remember that not everyone can play at one time. I shall not be critical unless I am willing to work to correct the problem. I shall attend my child's games because, it is important to them, they are not young forever. I shall be supportive when my child is successful or when struggling for success. I shall play and practice the skills of the game with my child. I shall be positive and supportive whether the team wins or loses. I shall remember that all managers, coaches are volunteers. I shall volunteer whenever possible. I shall retain perspective that there are no Major-League scouts in the stands. I shall remember that the game is for the kids.

**Remember: Good behavior does not cost anything! However, it does allow the players and other teams to enjoy a game between kids just for the fun of it.**

### **While at Love Hatbox Sports Complex, I will:**

Always be alert for traffic. Not play in the parking lots at any time. Not swing bats or throw baseballs at any time within the walkways and common areas. Not throw balls against dugouts, buildings or backstops. Not throw rocks. Not horseplay in walkways and dugouts at any time. Not climb fences. Observe ALL posted signs: Players and spectators should be Alert at all times for Foul Balls and Errant Throws. During games, remain in the dugout and/or spectator areas. Not use any profanity. Help clean up trash in the dugout and around stands after each game. There is **NO SMOKING** anywhere on, around or near the ball fields. Please refrain from smoking during any of our events. If you must smoke, you need to go to your vehicle.
