



WELCOME TO THE 2026 MYAA REC. BASEBALL SEASON!

We are excited to announce MYAA's **tentative** timeline for the 2026 Rec. League Baseball season! As we start the season in the very near future, there are some initial notes and dates that our league directors and commissioners would like to share with you to help give you an idea of general scheduling:



Boys Tee-Ball (4 thru 6 year-old's as of 8/31)

- Registration: Monday, 1/26/26 – Monday, 4/20/26
- Practices Begin: Saturday, 5/2/26
- Opening Day / Picture Day: Saturday, 5/30/26 @ Walnut Creek Complex
- Game Days: Various Days (Monday thru Friday)
- Season Ends: Third week of July



Bantam League (6 thru 8 year-old's as of 8/31)

- Registration: Monday, 1/26/26 – Monday, 4/6/26
- Skill Evaluation Tryouts: Saturday, 4/11/26 @ Hanlon Sports Complex Turf -or- MIHS Gymnasium
 - ◆ Time -TBD- = Player's Last Name (**A-L**) >Arrive by TBD<
 - ◆ Time -TBD- = Player's last name (**M-Z**) >Arrive by TBD<
- Practices Begin: Saturday, 4/25/26
- Opening Day / Picture Day: Saturday, 5/30/26 @ Walnut Creek Complex
- Game Days: Various Days (Monday -thru- Friday)
- Season Ends: Third week of July



Minor & Major Leagues (9 thru 12 year-old's as of 8/31)

- Registration: Monday, 1/26/26 – Monday, 3/16/26
- Skill Evaluation Tryouts: Saturday, 3/21/26 @ Hanlon Sports Complex Turf -or- MIHS Gymnasium
 - ◆ Time -TBD- = **All Minor League players (age 10 & under as of 8/31/26)** >Arrive by TBD<
 - ◆ Time -TBD- = **All Major League players (age 11 & 12 as of 8/31/26)** >Arrive by TBD<
- Practices Begin: Saturday, 4/4/26
- Opening Day / Picture Day: Saturday, 5/2/26 @ Walnut Creek Complex
- Major League Game Days: Monday's and Wednesday's (excluding 5/25/26 – Memorial Day)
- Minor League Game Days: Tuesday's and Thursday's
- Season Ends: Third week of July



Junior League (13 thru 15 year-old's as of 8/31)

- Registration: Monday, 1/26/26 – Monday, 4/20/26
- Skill Evaluation Tryouts: Saturday, 4/25/26 @ TBD (10:00am – Noon)
- Practices Begin: Monday, 5/4/26
- Opening Day: Tuesday, 5/26/26 @ Feidler Field & Scott Park
- Game Days: Monday's -thru- Saturday's (excluding 7/3/26 thru 7/5/26)
- Season Ends: Third week of July
- Picture Day: Saturday, 5/30/26 @ Walnut Creek Complex



Player Equipment:

- MYAA will provide each player with a team shirt and hat.
- Each player must provide their own fielders mitt.
- Baseball cleats (no metal) are recommended but not required.
- Team bats will be provided at each field for TeeBall ONLY!
- Shared team batting helmets are provided at each field. However, it is highly recommended that each player purchases their own batting helmet. (Mark your players name inside the helmet with a Sharpie).



All bats must meet the USA Baseball Bat standard (USABat) and be labeled as such.

BBCOR bats may also be used in Junior League and must be labeled as such.

USSSA BATS ARE NOT PERMITTED DURING PRACTICES OR GAMES!

Tee Ball:

Under the USABat standard, certified Tee Ball bats (26" and shorter) will feature the USA Baseball label and text which reads: ONLY FOR USE WITH APPROVED TEE BALLS.

Bantam/Minor/Major Leagues:

Bats shall not be more than 33 inches in length; nor more than 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ inches in diameter, and if wood, not less than fifteen-sixteenths (15/16) inches in diameter (7/8 inch for bats less than 30") at its smallest part.

Wood bats taped or fitted with a sleeve may not exceed sixteen (16) inches from the small end.

Junior League:

Bats shall not be more than 34" inches in length; nor more than 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ inches in diameter, and if wood, not less than fifteen-sixteenths (15/16) inches in diameter (7/8 inch for bats less than 30") at its smallest part.

Wood bats taped or fitted with a sleeve may not exceed eighteen (18) inches from the small end.

Also, permitted for Junior League are bats meeting the BBCOR performance standard, and so labeled.
