Parent/Family Member

Any JCSC parent asked to leave a game by a referee, or who is mentioned in a referee incident report for Behavioral conduct issues will be suspended for two (2) games. If that same parent is asked to leave a game or mentioned in an incident report a second time in the same season they will be suspended for the rest of the season, including possible carry over suspensions into the following year if the incident occurs towards the end of the season. (To be determined by the JCSC Executive Board). Also, any parent involved in a physical confrontation with another JCSC parent, player or coach, or an opposing team player, parent, or coach will be suspended for the season including possible carry over suspension into the following season. Suspended parents will not be allowed on or near our fields or any other field JCSC team is playing in during the full length of their suspension. Failure to adhere to this policy and suspensions will result in further disciplinary action up to and including the possible dismissal of their child from the program. This policy applies to any friend, relative, or spectator of JCSC as well. We are not asking people to be quiet in the stands...quite the contrary, we are hoping our fans will vocally support our teams when they play...just keep it positive!

Player Behavior

Any player of JCSC who receives a red card will be suspended from play for the mandatory EDP/MAPS suspension + additional equal suspension from the JCSC executive board pending an Executive Board review. Suspended players will not be allowed to play in a game until they meet with the JCSC Executive Board and additional punishment is determined.

Trainer/Coach/Manager Behavior

Any JCSC coach who is red carded for any reason or mentioned in a referee incident report will serve the Mandatory suspension + additional equal suspension from the JCSC Executive Board pending an Executive Board Review. A suspended coach will not be allowed to be on the bench for games until they have met with the JCSC Executive Board. Any coach who fails to comply with this policy will be immediately relieved of his/her coaching duties. The JCSC Executive Board is responsible to investigate all complaints made against JCSC players, parents, or Coaches. The Executive Board is made up of the JCSC President, Vice President, Reporting Secretary and Treasurer. Investigations will be handled in a thorough fashion in accordance with the Executive Board. There is a proper way to deal with bad behavior of our coaches, players and parents. Also, if you see bad behavior from an opposing team you are welcome to report that to the JCSC board who will share it appropriately with the opposing club. You are NOT empowered to deal with the bad behavior of an opposing team or fans yourself...nor are you allowed to be abusive to referee's.

We have worked hard to build a program known for the talent and hard work of our teams on the field and the positive sportsmanship of our members. This is youth soccer, not the MLS. We will have a program known for sportsmanship and positive behavior regardless of where we are or what happens on the field or in the stands. Please do your part and be a role model for your kids and those around you. And remember what youth soccer is all about...teaching life lessons as well as the awesome game of soccer! Don't forget to cheer in a positive way for your team!
