



*Mean Machine Sports Meeting Minutes
March 14, 2026*

Meeting called to order at the Grace Community Center (Waverly, Ohio) at 3 p.m. by Jack Cooper, II.

- The meeting was opened by Jack.
- Time for public concerns was provided. No individuals were present that presented any concerns or questions at this time. The time for public concerns was closed, and the board entered the executive session.
- Secretary Report:
 - The previous meeting minutes were read. There were no corrections or additions. Greg made a motion to approve the secretary's report, and Bryan seconded the motion. Voice vote. Motion passed.
- Treasurer Report:
 - Jack presented the current treasurer's report. There were no corrections or additions. The general fund was presented. Bryan made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, and Greg seconded the motion. Voice vote. Motion passed.
- Old Business:
 - Discuss the 2025-2026 Futsal Season (League & Tournaments)
 - Shared information on feedback from coaches from the league and tournament. No concerns noted.
- New Business:
 - Discussed dates for the 2026-2027 season. Will be adding an additional game date in November (late), which will add two games to the SOFL season. Will add an adult division to the league. The cost of a team entry may be adjusted, pending the outcome of Jack's cost analysis for the upcoming season. Dates were discussed and Jack will follow up with Ohio University to secure each of the dates discussed. Bryan made a motion to approve the addition of a date. Greg seconded the motion. Voice vote. Motion passed.
 - Jack will put together dates for practice. Skill day will occur during the last Sunday of October (2026). And the Southern Ohio Futsal Classic tournament will occur during the first full weekend of February (2027).
 - Jack will continue to be the Futsal Director; Greg will help assist with the high school girls and U12 coed age divisions coaching and recruitment. Bryan will help with the high school boys and U14 coed age divisions, coaching and recruiting. Jack will continue

working with all groups (including the U9 coed) and the group will seek out additional coaches to assist with the season, training, and coaching.

- The group discussed potential equipment needs in 2026-2027. A set of four new games balls and potential goal net replacements were discussed, but nothing was approved. The group will revisit the need for equipment, if the needs occur during the upcoming 2026-2027 season.
 - Marketing was discussed, along with potential sponsors for the 2025-2026 season. Due to the limited marketing budget, no advertisements were approved at this time. The current board members will split up geographical areas within Pike, Ross, & Scioto counties, in search of business sponsorships.
 - The group discussed individual registrations and recruitment for new/existing club players. The group will be splitting up school districts and approaching each district with recruitment information. The division of districts will be discussed at the next board meeting.
 - Board member updates; Jared and Julie have reached the limit of their board member terms and will no longer serve directly on the board as directors. They shared that they would continue to volunteer for the club/league/tournament, as their schedules allow. Andrea's resignation (which occurred during the 2025-2026 season) from the board was officially accepted. No new board members were discussed or added. The board of directors will be limited to a five-person board, with one position remaining vacant until an appropriate person is presented to fill it.
- Bryan made a motion for the meeting to be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Greg. Voice vote. Motion Passed.
