

GILROY LL DIVISION OVERVIEWS

Girls Juniors Division

Overview The Junior League Softball division is a program for players ages 13-14 and uses a conventional 60-foot diamond with a 43-foot pitching distance. A local league may dual-roster 12-year-olds, assessed capable, to a Major and a Junior division softball teams. The local league has an option to choose a Tournament Team (or "All Stars") of 12-14-year-olds from within this division (and/or from within the Girls Senior League Softball Division), and the team may enter the International Tournament.

Ages	League Age 13 & 14
Team Formation	Draft or one Team only with a max of 16 players and is normally formed by the Player Agent and Division Representative.
League Provides	Team jersey, hat, socks, and belt
Equipment Needed	Glove, baseball pants, and cleats. Some parents may choose to purchase a bat and/or helmet for their child's use.
Events per Week	4
Games	Home games played at Christmas Hill Park, will have to travel for some away games within Santa Clara County
Time Limits	No time limit
Offense	Continuous batting order.
Defense	9 players
Pitching	Player Pitch at 43 feet
Minimum Play Time	Continuous batting order. 9 defensive outs
Stealing	Bases are 60' apart. Players may steal all bases. No leading off allowed.
Runs	10 run rule applies
Standings	Standings are calculated by 1) Winning Percentage in League, 2) Head to Head and, 3) Runs Against.
Playoffs	If there is more than one team, then, Double Elimination format. All teams make the playoffs, seeding determined by regular season standings.
Pinch Runners	None
Tournament Team	Chance to be chosen on the Tournament Team (All-Star Team). GLL can enter only one team to the Juniors Tournament.
