

2020 CULL Safety Guidelines

- All coaches and participants are expected to follow CDC guidelines and maintain social distancing at all times
- When the social distancing recommendations of 6' cannot be maintained, coaches and participants are highly encouraged to wear face masks
- When actively participating, players are not not required to wear a mask
- All coaches must sanitize equipment before and after every game and practice
- Players personal items must be placed 6' apart at all times
- Only 3 players at a time are allowed in the dugout. Players will sit with their parent/guardian when not in the dugout and keep their equipment with them
- Do to the lack of trash receptacles in the dugouts, no food or drinks are allowed in the dugouts. Drinks and or snacks can be kept with the players equipment outside the dugout
- No bleacher seating is available
- Group sizes are limited to 50 participants
- Spectators are expected to maintain social distancing of 6' at all times and are encouraged but not required to wear a face mask
- Site Supervisors will be present to assist in contact tracing in case of exposure and are present to help maintain safety guidelines
- All spectators MUST sign the Spectator Log from the Site Supervisor
- Site Supervisors have the right to ask spectators to relocate or leave the field area when the maximum number of spectators has been reached
- Each team, Home and Away, are allowed 50 spectators each
- No player will be allowed to play if they are demonstrating any symptoms or have a known exposure to someone positive for Covid-19
- A wellness screening will be performed on each player prior to the start of any practice or game

Exposure

- If a player or coach has a known exposure to Covid-19 and shows symptoms, the player/coach must quarantine for 14 days and must notify the league immediately
- If the player/coach has a known exposure to Covid-19 and does not show symptoms, the player/coach must quarantine for 14 days and must notify the league immediately
- If the player/coach has any of the symptoms of Covid-19 but has not had a known exposure, the player/coach must quarantine for 14 days unless proof of a negative test is provided
- If the player/coach shows no symptoms of Covid-19 but has a positive test, you must quarantine for 14 days after the date of the positive test

In the event of an outbreak or if ordered by the Park District, CULL or IDPH, there will be NO REFUNDS after August 4, 2020
