Team Registration Fee

Team fee to participate is \$500 due at time of registration to reserve your spot.

Deposits are non-refundable via credit card or e-checks only.

Registration will include:

- Team flag belts that are yours to keep after the event
 - Event entry for a maximum of 10 players
 - Event entry for a maximum of 2 coaches
 - Tournament Jersey for you to keep after the event
 - Athlete gift handed out at registration

Team Check-in on-site @ Mecklenburg Sportsplex Area B Main Pavilion:

- Fri Dec 12 @ 7:30am-11am (teams may check in 90 minutes prior to first game)
- To expedite your team check-in, make sure all athlete and coach waivers are completed online prior to arrival.

Hotel Bookings

All athletes and coaches must purchase and stay at pre-selected hotels for the duration of their trip. Negotiated hotel rates are guaranteed to be lower than those currently on the market.

Spectators can opt to stay at hotels outside the blocks; HOWEVER, if they want to stay with the team in our designated hotels, they can be added to the rooming list.

2-night minimum stay starting at \$64 per person (all taxes & fees included)

10 room nights minimum booked per team (could be 5 rooms for 2 nights or 10 rooms for 1 night)

"The Crown Classic is a stay to play event. Teams who live 60 miles or more away from the Sportsplex are required to use the hotel booking link. Teams within 60 miles are not required to but may also use the link, if desired*"

Additional Hotel Booking Notes

- Every room must have at least one (1) adult over the age of 21
- Standard rooms are a maximum of 4 people (including infants) (maximum of two children per queen/king bed)
- Credit card options available: AMEX, Discover, Mastercard, Visa
- 1 unique email is required for each team coach and/or main team contact email preferred
- All athletes and coaches are required to sign & submit a waiver + code of conduct agreements online prior to arrival
- Add-on Experiences: There will NOT be any ticket distribution at the event. Tickets must be purchased online/digitally directly through vendor
- Just like most sporting events across the country, we are continuing a clear bag policy for spectators at both the competition venues. A separate athlete/coach entry may be designated. Safety first, so plan accordingly!
- Hotel rewards can now be earned with your stays, so take advantage just provide your number(s) during the booking process or to the front desk at check-in. Unfortunately, you cannot redeem any free stays in lieu of your hotel requirements.
- All taxes & credit card fees are included in the pricing. Any other parking fees, resort fees, complimentary breakfast, free shuttles, etc. are noted in the hotel descriptions during the booking process.
- If credit card expiration occurs prior to arrival, the system will reject the card. Please plan accordingly.

Event Transportation –Airport Transfers (Football – Matthews Area)

Airport Transfers to Matthews Area (Football):

- Distance: The distance between Matthews and Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT) is roughly 19 miles
- Travel Time: The average travel time between the two locations is around 29 minutes

Getting To The Airport:

- Driving: Leaving the sports complex, follow Sports Pkwy, left at Brigman Rd, right onto E. Independence Blvd, take exit 253A towards Pineville & I-485 South, continue 16 miles & go left onto I-485 South toward Huntersville, go 9.2 miles to take exit 9 onto Wilkinson Blvd US-29 toward CLT Airport
- No Direct Bus: There isn't a direct bus from CLT to Matthews, so you'll need to transfer.
- CATS Bus: Line 5 to Transit Center: Take the Line 5 bus from the airport to the Transit Center- 4th & Brevard station. Transfer to Line 27: From the Transit Center, transfer to the Line 27 bus towards Matthews. Line 27 to Matthews: The Line 27 bus will take you to Matthews.

- You can find a variety of vehicles, including economy, midsize, full-size, luxury cars, minivans, and SUVs




Event Transportation Public Transportation


Daily - Self Parking

Daily parking is available first come first served.

Mecklenburg Sportsplex-FREE

 If you park at the stadium, you are roughly ¼ mile (about 4-minute walk) away from where games are being played in Area B (Fields 5-9)



Competition Venue Spectator Tickets Available

- Single day, event admission tickets for the Mecklenburg Sportsplex can be purchased individually at www.popwarner.com anytime prior to arrival starting on Mon Dec 1
- Pricing: \$40 for two-day pass or daily admission of \$25 per day
 - Under 2 years old no charge
 - Two-day pass includes access to watch Pop Warner Superbowl Finals inside the stadium
- We highly recommend buying your event admission tickets prior to arriving at the venue to help expedite your arrival experience

Waivers & Code of Conduct

All rostered athletes & coaches are required to sign an electronic waiver prior to arrival.

Coaches are also required to read the Code of Conduct in this manual.





Waivers & Code of Conduct

Waivers must be completed during your registration. Deadline for completed waivers is Wed Nov 26 @ 12pm.

All athletes and coaches are required to sign a waiver. If any waivers are incomplete, the team will run the risk of not being able to compete and not receiving their welcome gift. Please ensure that your team is in compliance to avoid any disappointment upon arrival. (If an athlete and/or coach does not have an email, please use the head coaches' email.)

All waiver lists need to match your rooming list for the event, as an event credential for entry into competition venues will be given to each official participant upon check in at the start of the event.

Spectators do not need to sign waivers, but will be accountable to uphold the Code of Conduct. No alcohol or drugs are allowed on venue premises.

In the event of any excessive behavior issues, law enforcement involvement, confrontations, etc. at event venues, hotels, activities and/or restaurants, the team will be in jeopardy of having their participation revoked in the Crown Classic at any time during the week.

NO REFUNDS will be given on any team registration fee or unused hotel stays.



Waivers & Code of Conduct (contd.)

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

The Crown Classic is committed to cultivating a safe and welcoming environment for its regional and national events and programs that **encourages** and **promotes** good sportsmanship by **student-athletes**, parents, coaches, administrators and other spectators. We ask that event participants and attendees cooperate in being respectful at all practice and competition venues, partner hotels and/or ancillary venues throughout the course of the event. All those involved with the event are expected to refrain from the following behaviors:

- 1. Acting in a way that is unruly, disruptive or illegal in nature.
- 2. Intoxication or other signs of impairment that may potentially result in bad behavior.
- 3. Excessive use of profanities and other vulgar **language that** interfere with other attendees' ability to enjoy the event.
- 4. Using bigoted, demeaning or abusive or other disruptive and intimidating language and/or gestures.
- 5. Verbal or physical harassment of officials, participants and coaches before, during and following the competition.
- 6. Disrupting the progress of competition (including physically entering or throwing objects onto the playing field or competition mat).
- 7. Interfering with or failing to abide by security or emergency procedures or response.
- 8. Displaying signs that contain offensive language, or any graphic art that may be deemed disrespectful.
- 9. Defacing, destruction or theft of property associated with the event, including property of the opposing team or other participants, including officials, as well as official venues.
- Violence or threats of violence against other individuals at any official venue.
- **11. Publicly** criticizing or making derogatory statements of an official, opposing teams, event personnel or its policies, or other individuals associated with the event. This includes comments with respect to their conduct, character, competence, integrity or appearance. *Note: social media is deemed a public forum*.
- 12. Failing to follow instructions of event personnel.
- 13. Any behavior which otherwise violates conduct codes set by partner venues, hotels or ancillary venues including but not limited to theme parks, as enforced by those properties.

Failure to abide by these expectations are grounds for removal from competition. The Queen City Crown Open reserves the right to remove individuals or the entire team. Depending on the infraction, a one-year ban from Pop Warner events and programs will be considered. A repeat offense of the same infraction may result in a permanent ban. All removals will be without **refund**.

 - The age cutoff for the 2025 Crown Classic Flag Football Tournament is August 1st, 2025.

- Bracket play (min. 1 game) single elimination
- Running clock
- (2) 12-minute halves & 1-minute halftime
- Wilson football provided for game play
- Not provided but required: mouthguards & pocketless shorts
- All games will be played in accordance with the official NFL FLAG Rule Book

Crown Classic Articles of Compliance



- l. Mandatory Team check in must report to the Mecklenburg County Sportsplex.
- II. All documentation must be in a presentable and orderly manner ready for inspection at Team Certification. If any documentation is found to be missing, forged or tampered with, the player(s) in question will not be permitted to participate. We are accepting documents uploaded to Sports Connect during your team registration.
- III. Teams must have their books in a presentable and orderly manner ready for inspection at Certification/Check-In. Rosters, ID's, physical forms, parental consent forms will be checked for accuracy and validity. If any paperwork is found to be missing, forged or tampered with the player(s) in question will not be permitted to participate. **We** are accepting documents uploaded in the Sports Connect roster software system as well.
- IV. All players must be listed on the team's Official Certified Roster.
- V. WILSON is the official game ball of the Crown Classic. Balls will be provided at no cost by Pop Warner and MUST be used during games. Composite and leather material footballs will be provided.
- VI. All teams will be provided with reversible jerseys at check-in. Teams must wear the jerseys provided.
- VII. Proper Coaching attire shall consist of a collared shirt and slacks or Coaching shorts. (Slacks/Shorts/joggers color can vary i.e. Khaki, Navy, and Black etc.... Jeans and Cargo pants/shorts are NOT permitted) Collared shirts should have Team/Association/League name and/or logo. (Team jerseys, sleeveless shirts, tank tops, throwback jerseys and the like are not acceptable sideline coaching attire).

Crown Classic Articles of Compliance



- IX. All teams MUST stay on partnership property throughout the event to participate and REMAIN eligible for the Crown Classic
- X. All teams will observe a 10:00 P.M. Curfew. As such, all players must be in their assigned sleeping rooms by 10:00 P.M. or players, coaches, the team and/or association shall be subject to disciplinary action including but not limited to forfeiture of past or future game decisions, suspension, removal from partnering property, financial penalties and/or permanent removal from the tournament.
- XI. However, participants accompanied by their designated chaperones that are at least 21 years or older who are returning from organized team activities (including without limitation theme park excursions, group dinners, or the add-on events outside of their hotels shall be excused from such curfew but MUST be immediately escorted by such chaperones to their rooms upon returning to their hotels. To clarify, when at Partner Hotels, ALL participants MUST be in their rooms by 10:00 P.M. regardless of whether their competition has begun, is ongoing or is completed. Any players found outside their assigned rooms past 10:00 P.M. while they are still registered as a participating group shall be subject to disciplinary action along with their coaches, teams, and/or associations as stated above. Pop Warner National and Event Staff shall be conducting daily checks to ensure compliance.
- XII. In order to fairly and promptly address any behavior at or associated with the Crown Classic Flag event involving any and all violations of the General and Members Codes of Conduct, policy or rules' violations and/or behavior that resulted in harm or may result in probable harm to participants, volunteers, parents, spectators or other individuals, such aforementioned behavior shall be governed by the Disciplinary Review Board (DRB) as outlined in the DRB Policies. All Head Coaches must read the DRB Policies and sign the attached Statement of Acceptance in order to participate in the Crown Classic. Copies of the DRB Policies are provided under separate cover. Forms requesting a hearing as well as a copy of the DRB process will be available upon request at the Volunteer Room located at "X" during the duration of the Crown Classic.
 - As a condition of your team's participation in the Crown Classic, all participants, coaches, administrators and supporters agree to display good sportsmanship throughout the event and related events or the entire team's eligibility and presence on site may be revoked without refund. Every Head Coach is required to read and sign the event's Coaches Code of Conduct to ensure an understanding of what is acceptable conduct for all teams and supporters. Head Coaches are responsible for not only their own proper behavior, but also for the behavior of each member of their staff, their team and ALL of the team's supporters.

Crown Classic Articles of Compliance



- The Head Coach will be held accountable for proper conduct of coaches, parents and any other persons affiliated with the team. Head Coaches must read and review the "Personal Responsibility at PWLS Events and Sportsmanship" memos contained in this packet with your entire team.
- Players, coaches, administrators and parents or other supporters that violate these articles, rules and regulations and/or any Crown Classic rules while in attendance will be subject to disciplinary action including but not limited to removal from the Mecklenburg County Sportsplex and Partnering properties without refund, disqualification from the event and any applicable legal/criminal penalties.
- ALL teams must stay on partnership property throughout the event to participate and REMAIN eligible for the Crown Classic 2 night minimum stay will be enforced. (STAY TO PLAY supercedes the night minimum stay)
- General code of conduct: General Code of Conduct (popwarner.com)
- Members code of conduct: Members Code of Conduct (popwarner.com)
- XIV. Schedule—All teams are offered and committed to playing 3 pool play games Friday. All teams are guaranteed 4 games. All Championship games will be played on Saturday December 13th.
- XV. In the event of a tie, overtime procedure will be utilized.
- XVI. In accordance with and in addition to the Revised Article 17 of the Pop Warner Rule Book, injured participants may NOT return to practice/performance without explicit approval from assigned medical personal including, but not limited to, Athletic Trainers and/or Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs).
