This manual will help in your trip planning to Charlotte, NC & provide a more seamless experience throughout the booking process.

Please take the time to familiarize yourself with the enclosed information, as there have been numerous changes included for 2025 based on guest feedback from previous years:

- **Combined booking process – request your base packages & secure your hotel rooms together**
- **Sign up as early as Sept 2 (Queen City Crown Open)**
- **Non-Refundable Deposit**
 - Sept 2 – 30 (Queen City Crown Open) - only \$1000 non-refundable early deposit is required with remaining \$500 balance due prior to final payment deadline
 - \$1500 team non-refundable deposit is required to book the initial package for the entire team starting Oct 1
- **Additional activities optional**
- **Lower lead in package pricing**
- **Range of hotel properties with tiered pricing to fit any budget - budget, moderate, premium**
- **Local add-on experiences (purchase directly through venue)**
- **No bus transportation - some cheer & dance hotels are within walking distance or close proximity to public transportation**

Enclosed are booking guidelines, pricing, add-on experiences, payment timelines & more.

Step 1 – read the following manual carefully

Step 2 – visit the registration portal to start booking your package

- **Booking windows will open the Monday following your Regional Qualifiers, AFTER your region staff has submitted their official winners list & been approved by Nationals**
- **Teams can register as early as Sep 2 for Cheer & Dance (early registration guarantees you in the Open Division - your team will be automatically transferred to Nationals if you qualify)**
- **Payment timelines will be strictly enforced – with a booking packages & hotels now in a single step, so late payments will result in rooms being cancelled.... please don't let this happen to your team!**

Base Packages Overview

All athletes and coaches of both football and cheer & dance teams must purchase this package and stay at pre-selected hotels for the duration of their trip.

Spectators can opt to stay at hotels outside the blocks; HOWEVER, if they want to stay with the team in our designated hotels, they must buy the spectator lower priced package. Negotiated hotel rates are guaranteed to be lower than those currently on the market.

****Teams non-compliant are subject to fee and may not participate in event; this includes teams that change hotel accommodations during the course of the event.***

Base Packages Overview

Congratulations on qualifying for the 2025 Pop Warner National Championship Week! Specially priced packages have been created for your trip to Charlotte.

This year we are again offering more hotel options, so you can find a hotel price point that works best for your team. Spectators can also take advantage of specially-priced packages offered by adding their names on the team's rooming list.

Package booking has never been easier. Our online booking system will expedite your registration process. No need to make a phone call to book your package, unless you would like extra assistance. The choice is yours!

Package bookings have been combined into a **ONE STEP** process:

★ Book your package for all athletes & coaches including your preferred hotel (based on availability).

★ Parents & other spectators traveling with the team can also be added.

★ In addition to a wide variety of tiered hotels, we are excited to showcase additional add-on options to enhance your stay in the Charlotte area. These new options are to be purchased outside of the registration portal. This allows for increased flexibility in package bookings to keep your base package as low as possible, while giving you the opportunity to customize your group's experience. You are ultimately in control of your team's journey!

★ Carefully note payment deadlines, as there will not be any opportunity for late payments prior to rooms being dropped for other guests.

- One (1) event admission ticket into competition Dec 6-13, 2025 at both Mecklenburg Sportsplex (football) & Charlotte Convention Center (cheer and dance)
 - Event admission ticket is non-transferable and non-refundable
 - Event lanyards for all coaches and athletes
- Athlete welcome gift
 - Cheer & Dance given out at Charlotte Convention Center
 - Football given out at registration at Mecklenburg Sportsplex

Additional Base Package Notes

- Every room must have at least one (1) adult over the age of 21 - all people in the room must buy the package
- Resort availability is first come first served. **NEW FOR 2025** – cheer & dance registration opens Sep 2. A team's place at regional championships will determine if they qualify for Nationals or can compete in the Queen City Crown Open. Teams may choose to register after their regional event, as they've done in the past, but resort selection may be limited. We HIGHLY encourage early registration. Football qualifying will remain the same as previous years, as regions qualifying earlier will have the best selection of properties
- Standard rooms are a maximum of 4 people (including infants) – hotels with higher room capacities are noted in the descriptions
- Package initial deposit is \$1,500 (\$1,000 for early cheer deposit with remaining \$500 balance prior to balance deadline). Deposit will be applied to the team contact booking the reservation. ***Many credit cards have daily maximum limits, so know these & increase, if necessary, prior to starting this process***
- Airport transfers are not included in the package - reference the "Airport Transfers/Bus Information" page of the manual for options available
- Credit card options available: AMEX, Discover, Mastercard, Visa, Echeck (no pre-paid cards)
- 1 unique email is required for each team – coach and/or main team contact email preferred
- All athletes and coaches are required to sign & submit a waiver + code of conduct agreements online prior to arrival
- If you have sister teams wanting to stay near each other, we recommend booking simultaneously
- Add-on Experiences: There will NOT be any ticket distribution at the event. Tickets must be purchased online/digitally directly through vendor
- Payment plan option allows multiple, pre-set dates leading up to the final deadline for payments to be scheduled
- Just like most sporting events across the country, we are continuing a **clear bag policy** for spectators at both the competition venues. A separate athlete/coach entry may be designated. Safety first, so plan accordingly!

Event Transportation –Airport Transfers (Cheer & Dance – Uptown Area)

Airport Transfers to Uptown Charlotte (Cheer & Dance):

- Distance: The distance between Uptown Charlotte and Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT) is roughly 8 miles
- Travel Time: The average travel time between the two locations is around 16 minutes

Getting To The Airport:

- Driving: You can take I-277 to I-77 South, then exit to Billy Graham Parkway and travel approximately five miles, exiting after the third traffic light at the Charlotte Douglas International Airport exit
- Bus: The Line 5 bus can take you from Uptown Charlotte to Charlotte Douglas Airport
- Taxi/Ride-sharing: Taxis and ride-sharing services like Uber and Lyft are also available

Cost:

- Bus: The fare for the airport-uptown express bus route is \$2.20 each way
- Taxi: A taxi ride from Uptown Charlotte to Charlotte Douglas International Airport can cost between \$30 and \$40
- Ride-sharing: The average price for a ride-sharing service like Uber is around \$22

Event Transportation –Airport Transfers (Football – Matthews Area)

Airport Transfers to Matthews Area (Football):

- Distance: The distance between Matthews and Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT) is roughly 19 miles
- Travel Time: The average travel time between the two locations is around 29 minutes

Getting To The Airport:

- Driving: Leaving the sports complex, follow Sports Pkwy, left at Brigman Rd, right onto E. Independence Blvd, take exit 253A towards Pineville & I-485 South, continue 16 miles & go left onto I-485 South toward Huntersville, go 9.2 miles to take exit 9 onto Wilkinson Blvd US-29 toward CLT Airport
- No Direct Bus: There isn't a direct bus from CLT to Matthews, so you'll need to transfer.
- CATS Bus : Line 5 to Transit Center: Take the Line 5 bus from the airport to the Transit Center- 4th & Brevard station. Transfer to Line 27: From the Transit Center, transfer to the Line 27 bus towards Matthews. Line 27 to Matthews: The Line 27 bus will take you to Matthews.

Other Options:

- Taxi or ride-sharing service
- Driving is your best option for flexibility & distance

Event Transportation – Rental Cars



In Charlotte, NC, major rental car providers like Hertz, National, Enterprise, Alamo, and Avis, along with other brands, are located at the Charlotte Douglas International Airport's Consolidated Rental Car Facility.

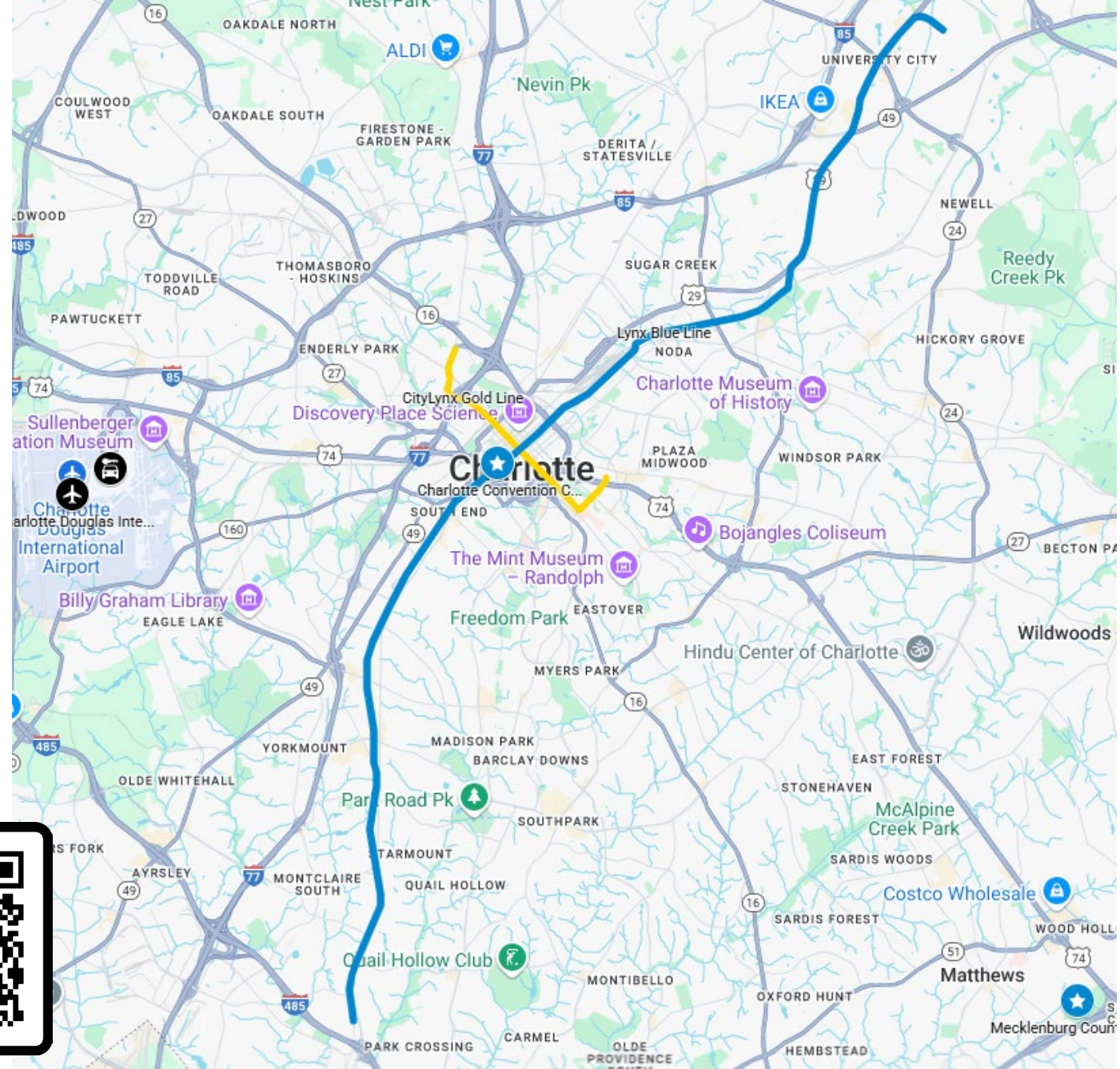
- [Hertz](#), [National](#), [Enterprise](#), [Alamo](#), and [Avis](#) are the main players with a presence at the airport. Charlotte also offers other rental car brands
- All major agencies are located in the Level 2 lobby next to the Hourly Parking Deck, in front of the Arrivals terminal at Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT)
- You can find a variety of vehicles, including economy, midsize, full-size, luxury cars, minivans, and SUVs

Event Transportation Public Transportation

Charlotte offers a range of public transportation options, including an extensive bus system and the LYNX light rail service through the Charlotte Area Transit System (CATS). These convenient and accessible transit choices make it easier to navigate the city without a car.

****For travel directly between Matthews/Football & Uptown/Cheer & Dance, the closest CATS bus stop is located at Independence Pointe Pkwy & Matthews-Mint Hill Rd (approx. 21 min walk). The bus route serving this area is the #27 bus.**

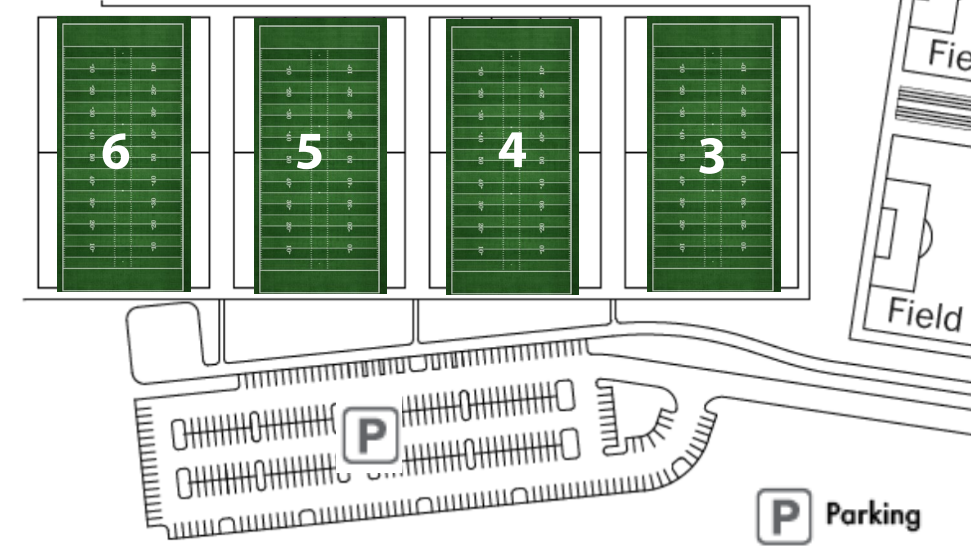

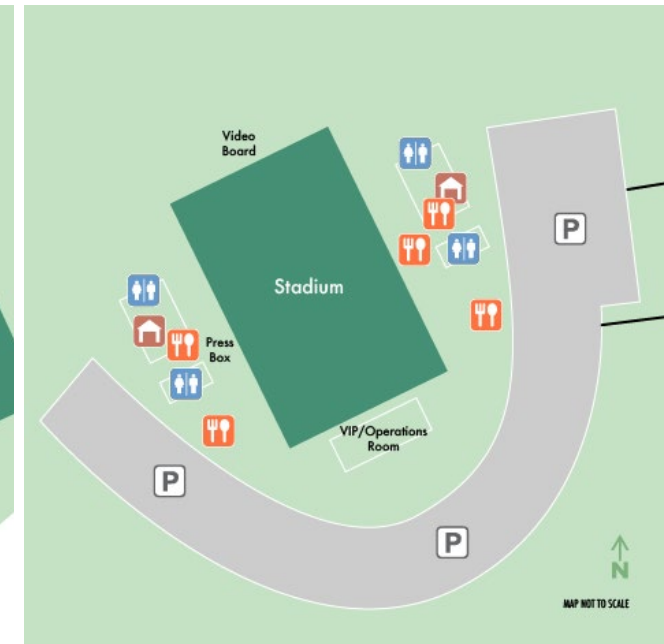

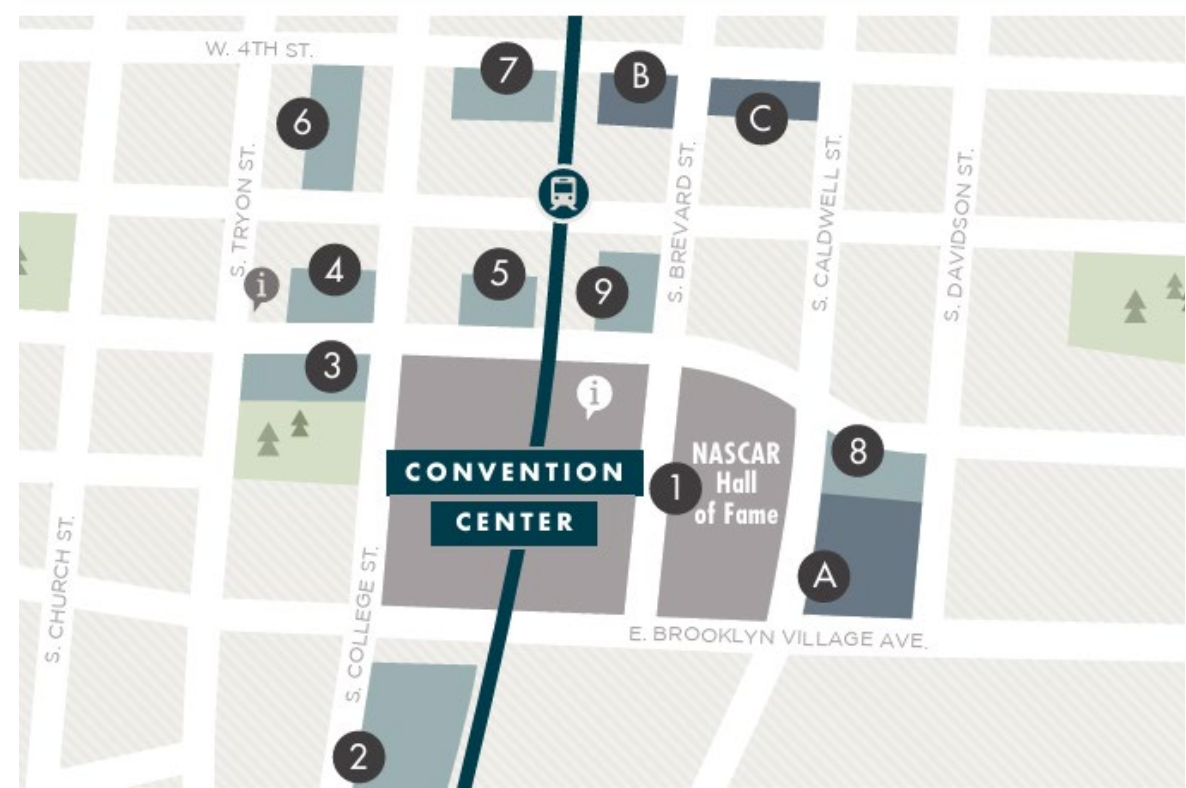

Hotels

Choose the option that fits your team's needs & budget. All rooms blocks & bookings are first come, first served.

We are holding room blocks between Dec 5-13. Size of room blocks vary widely by property, so we **HIGHLY RECOMMEND** you book rooms **ASAP** starting the Monday after your team qualifies. If your preferred hotel room block isn't available, you will be required to pick an alternate option.

In addition, we have been **GUARANTEED** the lowest hotel rates, so we encourage you to add your spectators onto your initial rooming block. There are several other events in Charlotte during our competition window, so the hotel rates will rise as event week gets closer. We don't recommend trying to "wing it".

Pricing grids for every property have been included at the back of this manual starting on **Hotel Pricing Grids by Property**

Hotels

Standard rooms are for a maximum of four people, while suites will accommodate a maximum of six people (max. two children per queen/king bed). *Children under two years of age are not charged for BUT are included in the room capacity counts. (1 heartbeat = 1 occupant)

Every room must have at least one (1) adult over the age of 21.

When booking your teams' rooms, take special note of the property descriptions as a majority of the hotels include free breakfast.

For your convenience & planning, we have also listed any applicable resort and/or parking fees charged directly by the hotel & room descriptions with occupancy capacity.

Hotels - Additional Notes

- Cheer & Dance Hotels: 19 hotels within 1 mile radius, 28 hotels within 5-10 mile radius, and 7 hotels within 10-20 mile radius of Charlotte Convention Center – *typically hotels further away from Uptown will be more affordable*
- Football Hotels: 3 hotels within 5-mile radius, 9 hotels within 6-10 mile radius, 12 hotels within 11-15 mile radius from Mecklenburg Sportsplex
- Hotel rewards can now be earned with your stays (except Marriott), so take advantage – just provide your number(s) to the front desk at check-in. Unfortunately, you cannot redeem any free stays in lieu of your package requirements.
- All taxes & credit card fees are included in the pricing. Any other parking fees, resort fees, complimentary breakfast, free shuttles, etc. are noted in the hotel descriptions during the booking process.
- If credit card expiration occurs prior to arrival, the system will reject the card. Please plan accordingly.
- Rollaway bed additions are not an option
- There are very few traditional multi-room suite properties in Charlotte.
- Rooms needing ADA access, please make notes on your reservation during the booking process
- If you are traveling with any sister teams & want to be blocked near each other, please include notes on your reservation during the booking process. Blocks are not guaranteed but will be taken into consideration by the property.
- Practice is restricted to the Charlotte Convention Center (cheer and dance) and OrthoCarolina and/or Mecklenburg Sportsplex (football) only. Practice may not be held inside or outside of participating hotels and/or hotel property.
- If you want to change your hotel location preference after originally booked with a deposit, you will be refunded the total amount minus a processing fee (unfortunately, the system is programmed to automatically charge you for this extra service). You can then book the new hotel.
- **Access to all hotel grids with pricing breakouts are available at the back of this manual.**

All rostered athletes & coaches are required to sign an electronic waiver prior to arrival.

Coaches are also required to read the Pop Warner Code of Conduct in this manual.



Waivers & Pop Warner Code of Conduct

Waiver online link will be emailed to your designated team contact the Wed after your qualifying weekend (open cheer & dance teams will receive link the week of Nov 3-7. Deadline for completed waivers is **Wed Nov 26 @ 12pm**. Team compliance will start to be checked the week of Nov 17 - 21, so we highly encourage your team to get these done early.

If any waivers are incomplete, the team will run the risk of not being able to compete and not receiving their welcome gift. Please ensure that your team is in compliance to avoid any disappointment upon arrival. (If an athlete and/or coach does not have an email, please use the head coaches' email.) *****Cheer & Dance teams without waivers 100% completed by the deadline will not be able to schedule an express registration time.**

All waiver lists need to match your rooming list for the event, as an event credential for entry into competition venues will be given to each official participant upon book check at the start of the event.


Spectators do not need to sign waivers but need to review and uphold the code of conduct.

Waivers & Pop Warner Code of Conduct (contd.)

All coaches, athletes, team administrators and spectators will be required to read and acknowledge a pledge to abide by the Code of Conduct of the Pop Warner organization.

In the event of any excessive behavior issues, law enforcement involvement, confrontations, etc. at event venues, hotels, activities and/or restaurants, the team will be in jeopardy of having their participation revoked in the Super Bowl and/or Cheer & Dance Nationals at any time during the championship week.

NO REFUNDS will be given on any package components or unused hotel stays.



Waivers & Pop Warner Code of Conduct

(contd.)

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

Pop Warner Little Scholars, Inc. is committed to cultivating a safe and welcoming environment for its regional and national events and programs that encourages and promotes good sportsmanship by student-athletes, parents, coaches, administrators and other spectators. We ask that event participants and attendees cooperate in being respectful at all practice and competition venues, partner hotels and/or ancillary venues throughout the course of the event. All those involved with the event are expected to refrain from the following behaviors:

1. Acting in a way that is unruly, disruptive or illegal in nature.
2. Intoxication or other signs of impairment that may potentially result in bad behavior.
3. Excessive use of profanities and other vulgar language that that interfere with other attendees' ability to enjoy the event.
4. Using bigoted, demeaning or abusive or other disruptive and intimidating language and/or gestures.
5. Verbal or physical harassment of officials, participants and coaches before, during and following the competition.
6. Disrupting the progress of competition (including physically entering or throwing objects onto the playing field or competition mat).
7. Interfering with or failing to abide by security or emergency procedures or response
8. Displaying signs that contain offensive language, or any graphic art that may be deemed disrespectful.
9. Defacing, destruction or theft of property associated with the event, including property of the opposing team or other participants, including officials, as well as official venues.
10. Violence or threats of violence against other individuals at any official venue.
11. Publicly criticizing or making derogatory statements of an official, opposing teams, event personnel or its policies, or other individuals associated with the event. This includes comments with respect to their conduct, character, competence, integrity or appearance. *Note: social media is deemed a public forum.*
12. Failing to follow instructions of event personnel.
13. Any behavior which otherwise violates conduct codes set by partner venues, hotels or ancillary venues including but not limited to theme parks, as enforced by those properties.

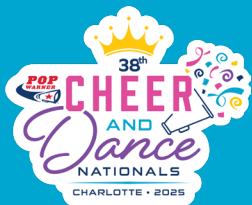
The Team Book Check, or Document Audit, may now include a review of digital files submitted into the Sports Connect roster software. If the Participant Contract & Parent Consent and YCADA Coaching Certification, as well as the Skill Progression Checklist, are verified in the software, they do not need to be included in the book. **Please include a signed copy of your league's Roster Compliance Affidavit** in their place. Note: Proof of scholastic fitness is only audited at the point of team certification; report cards are no longer audited at competition.

MUSIC VERIFICATION AREA: Immediately following Book Check, the Head Coach will proceed to a Music Preview Station to listen to and verify the team music. Music has been uploaded to this station following your Region Championships. After that time, there are no further changes to the routine music at Nationals with the exception of routine music that received a rules - Music Deduction (i.e., suggestive music or inappropriate for family viewing, etc.) at Region Championships. This type of Music Change (Music Deduction at Regions) must be submitted to National from the Region Coordinator no later than 5 business days following the Region event.

There will be no music changes / submissions accepted on location.

WARM UP AREA: A Pop Warner volunteer will welcome your team and escort them to the Warm-Up Area.

The Head Coach will present the Team Book for [Photo Identification Check](#) for each athlete/rostered coach to enter the warm-up area, backstage and coaches' seating area.

Each Pop Warner athlete must have the Pop Warner Patch secured to the uniform in order to proceed. The Head Coach should also come prepared with a backup copy of the team music (CD/iPhone/iPad/iPod, etc.) even though it has been uploaded to the warm-up area and performance floor.

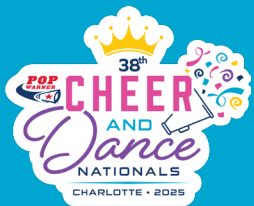
This station should take no more than 10 minutes. If discrepancies, the Region Cheer & Dance Coordinator will be on hand to resolve challenges with the Head Coach while the team and other rostered coaching staff will be permitted to keep with your scheduled warm-up time.

Once the Identification Check is complete, a Pop Warner volunteer will escort your team to one (1) of three designated mats (1, 2, 3) for warm-up, tumbling and stretching for a timed, 10 minute period (9 Minutes, 1 Minute to Exit Area).

The team will be asked to immediately move to one of three warm-up areas (1, 2, 3). A 54' x 42' surface will be provided (nine (9) panel matted surface) for a timed, 10 minute practice floor (9 Minutes, 1 Minute to Exit Area). The area will be equipped with a sound system (with uploaded music) for your warm-up time.

As soon as warm-up is complete, a Pop Warner volunteer will escort your team immediately backstage to the performance floor, entrance area.

PERFORMANCE FLOOR, ENTRANCE AREA: The team will move backstage (from the warm-up area) to the staging area. Members can leave team bags backstage in a designated area until your performance time is complete. The rostered coaches will be permitted to stay with the team until they are directed to the *Rostered Coaches' Area* on the main floor. When it is time to enter the performance floor, the emcee will announce your team to the floor as listed at time of registration. The athletes will enter the raised Performance Floor by ramp access, directly behind the performance floor, athlete stage right.

PERFORMANCE FLOOR, COACHES' VIEWING AREA: There is a designated area for the Rostered Coaching Staff on the main floor while your team performs. Coaches will enter the Performance Floor stage right and move to the main floor. At the end of the team performance, the staff will wait for the team to exit the floor and then will be directed to the back exit area curtain (stage left) to collect the team and belongings.

PERFORMANCE FLOOR, MUSIC STATION: The rostered Coach, in charge of music, will be directed to the Music Station at least 10 minutes prior to performance, enter stage right. There will be two stations, Preview and Performance. A **Technician will operate** the Performance Music Station (Press Play). At the end of the performance, the rostered Coach, in charge of music, will wait for the team to exit the floor and then join the remaining staff to exit area curtain (stage left) to collect the team and belongings.

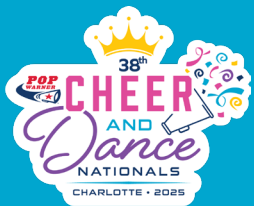
PERFORMANCE FLOOR: The competition area for the events will be approximately 54' x 42' deep (nine (9) panels). This is a raised platform with entry ramp access and exit stairs.

JUDGES and EVENT SPOTTERS: The Judges' Area will be directly in front of your team during their performance. Competition spotters will be provided for safety.

ATHLETIC TRAINER: An Athletic Trainer will be in the warm-up area and the exit area of the performance floor. In accordance with and in addition to the Revised Article 17 of the Pop Warner Rulebook, injured athletes may not return to practice/performance without explicit approval from the assigned event medical personnel, but not limited to, Athletic Trainers and/or Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs).

EXIT AREA: A team will exit the performance area, stage left rear, back of mat/stairs, and wait for the coaches to return from the Coaches' Seating Area. A volunteer will retain the team belongings, and each athlete will receive a Gatorade in this area. The team will be directed to the Charlotte Convention Center Lobby Area.

MEDIA/INTERVIEW STATIONS: Head Coaches and/or Teams may participate in an interview along with an Entertainment Representative inside the venue. Those interested will participate in a brief interview that may be live on the overhead screen and/or on the event livestream. SPECTATOR VIEWING AREA: Fans should arrive ten (10) minutes prior to the team's scheduled performance time at the Performance Floor Spectator Entrance. Fans will be directed into a secured area that will be closed before the team takes the floor. When the team's routine is complete, the fans will be escorted out of the viewing area in time for the next performance. All fans entering this area must show good sportsmanship, respect for the performers and also be aware of the Judges' view. **Fans will not be permitted to bring noise makers, megaphones, signs, shakers, etc. into this viewing area.** A photographer is on hand to provide action photos of your team. Photographs will be available for purchase at the Charlotte Convention Center. **Camera, video or any type of recording/photography including cell phones will not be permitted** in this Spectator Viewing Area to avoid distraction for the performers and judges.

AWARDS CEREMONY ANNOUNCEMENT: There will be multiple award ceremonies to coincide with current CDC and State/Local requirements. More information to follow.

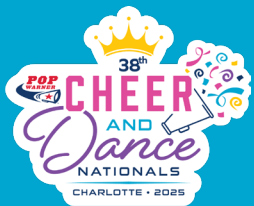

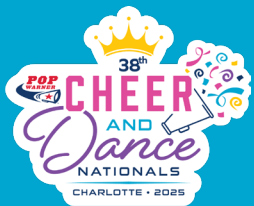

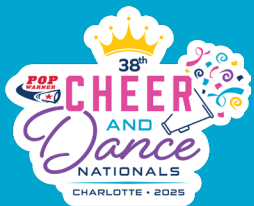


SCORESHEET DISTRIBUTION: Your score sheet package will be available for pick-up at exit of the Awards' Ceremony. The Head Coach, with picture identification, will be required to sign for score sheets. Only one person per team should come to the pick-area. Pop Warner Little Scholars, Inc. takes no responsibility for score sheets after the event has ended.

RULES REVIEW STATION: If your team receives a Rules Deduction, the listed Head Coach will receive a text message, approximately 10 minutes following your team's performance, and will be directed to report to the Rules Review Table, next to the Judges' Platform. At that time only, and if you have a Rules Deduction (does not include Point Deductions), the Head Coach with one Assistant Coach may request a brief meeting with the Head Rules Judge for video review to better understand a "listed" rules deduction for their team only.

ELECTRONIC TABULATION PROCEDURES: This Pop Warner Event allows each judge to input and assign a point system for Panel Scoring, Point Deduction or Legalities. All equipment and software has been tested and approved for use at the event. If after the Awards' Ceremony a correction is found caused by human tabulation error, the corrections would require a co-sharing of placements to be released immediately online.

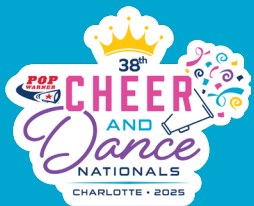

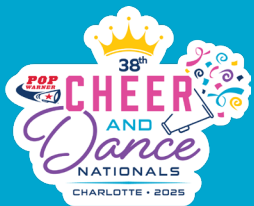


NATIONALS EVENT SPECIFIC CODE OF CONDUCT: With my event registration, I hereby acknowledge, understand and agree to the following:

- **Proper coaching attire** shall consist of Business, Business Casual or Game Day Attire in the form of a dress, suit, Khaki or dress pants and a polo (with Pop Warner Logo and/or Team/Association/League name and/or logo), or Team Sweat Suit/Athletic Sneakers with Pop Warner Team logo, etc.). The following items are not acceptable: Jeans, shorts, flip flops and/or tank tops. Coaching staff consists of Rostered Staff to include Coordinator, Coaches, Coach Trainee and Student Demonstrators.
- **All teams will observe a 10 p.m. Curfew.** As such, all athletes must be in their assigned sleeping rooms by 10:00 p.m. or athletes, coaches and/or the team and association as a whole shall be subject to disciplinary action including but not limited to forfeiture of competition awards, suspension, and removal from Resort property, financial penalties and/or permanent removal from Pop Warner. However, athletes accompanied by their designated chaperones that are at least 21 years or older who are returning from organized team activities (including without limitation theme park excursions, group dinners, etc.) outside of their hotels shall be excused from such curfew but must be immediately escorted by such chaperones to their rooms upon returning to their hotels. 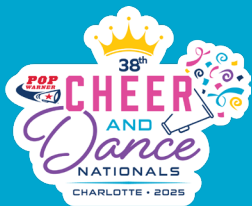

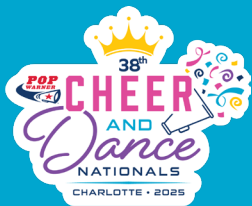

- Teams participating in Nationals and the Queen City Crown Open must have at least five (5) active/rostered athletes on the performance floor on event day.
- Rostered Cheerleading Teams with more than 2 male athletes (3 or more) will be placed in a Co-ed Category within their age division for Pop Warner Competitions, League/Region and National.
- Participants wearing a full medical boot brace/walking boot may not be involved in stunting or tumbling.
- Safety - In concentrated efforts to reduce the risk of injury to athletes, every region/national event will use every possible means to obtain performance mats for safety, as well as to secure professional spotters.

MUSIC POLICY: Ownership and creative rights of music are intellectual property covered by Copyright law. Pop Warner respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects all athletes to adhere to the following rules regarding use of third party music for cheer and dance performance:

- All music used for cheer and dance performance must be purchased from a source authorized to sell a copy.
- You may use a mix purchased from an authorized mix vendor.
- You may use a song in its complete original form, purchased from an authorized vendor (such as iTunes, or a traditional retail store).
- For either a mix or a complete song, save your receipt.
- Regional and National championship performances will be covered by licenses secured by Pop Warner Little Scholars.
- Any recording or broadcast of the cheer / dance event must be done with the music in background / off mic and with a voiceover describing the athletes and the performance.

- I. Mandatory Team check in must report to the Mecklenburg County Sportsplex.
- II. Team Certification & Book Check will be in Stadium at the Mecklenburg Sportsplex. Team Books and player picture ID's must be presented at certification and additional checks will be conducted prior to each game. Please bring Player/Coaches waivers to Certification/Book Check.
- III. Teams must have their books in a presentable and orderly manner ready for inspection at Certification/Check-In. Rosters, ID's, physical forms, parental consent forms will be checked for accuracy and validity. If any paperwork is found to be missing, forged or tampered with, the player(s) in question will not be permitted to participate. **We are accepting documents uploaded in the Sports Connect roster software system as well.**
- IV. Please check with your Region Director and/or the Document Audit information on how to organize for book checks.
- V. All players must be listed on the team's Official Certified Roster. Teams must provide absentee forms for any rostered players not in attendance.
 - Pop Warner will provide Mandatory Play Rosters (MPR) via the Roster System for book check.
- VI. MANDATORY Head Coaches Meetings: In order for you and your team to participate in the Super Bowl, each Head Coach MUST attend the appropriate mandatory meeting: both Friday & Saturday Meetings will be held in the Stadium at the Mecklenburg County Sportsplex.
 - Division II Age Base and 14U Division Head Coaches: Fri 12/5/25 at 2:00PM
 - Division I Age Base Head Coaches: Sat 12/6/25 at 2:00PM
 - League and Association Presidents will be allowed to attend as space permits.

- VII. WILSON is the official game ball of the Pop Warner Super Bowl. Balls will be provided at no cost by Pop Warner and MUST be used during Playoff and Championship games. Composite material footballs will be provided.
- VIII. All players shall wear helmets that carry a warning label regarding the risk of injury and a manufacturer's or reconditioner's certification indicating satisfaction of NOCSAE standards. All such reconditioned helmets shall show recertification to indicate satisfaction with the NOCSAE standard. The coach's pregame verification to the referee and another game official that all players are legally equipped and in compliance with the rules includes the exterior warning label.

- IX. All teams must come prepared with two (2) sets of game jerseys (HOME & AWAY), one of which White (AWAY) and the other clearly a dark color (HOME). Teams will be responsible for obtaining proper color jerseys should they fail to bring both. All teams MUST have the Pop Warner Patch displayed on ALL uniforms in the Pop Warner approved designated areas or may not be permitted to participate.
- X. Proper Coaching attire shall consist of a collared shirt and slacks or Coaching shorts. (Slacks/Shorts/joggers color can vary i.e. Khaki, Navy, and Black etc.... Jeans and Cargo pants/shorts are NOT permitted) Collared shirts should have Pop Warner Logo and/or Team/Association/League name and/or logo. (Team jerseys, sleeveless shirts, tank tops, throwback jerseys and the like are not acceptable sideline coaching attire).
- Practice fields will be provided at the Ortho-Carolina Sportsplex during the week,. Teams MUST reserve practice times online at the National Championship website. Release days and times will be communicated to head coaches.
 - Practice in any other areas is strictly prohibited. Practice times are limited to 1 practice prior to each game and are strictly non-contact. (Helmets may be worn) If your team cannot make your scheduled practice, you MUST go online and cancel in advance of your starting practice time or you may forfeit any remaining practices and will be charged a \$150 fine for NO CALL, NO SHOW.

- All teams MUST stay on a partnership property throughout the event to participate and REMAIN eligible for the Super Bowl.
- XII. All teams will observe a 10:00 P.M. Curfew. As such, all players must be in their assigned sleeping rooms by 10:00 P.M. or players, coaches, the team and/or association shall be subject to disciplinary action including but not limited to forfeiture of past or future game decisions, suspension, removal from partnering property, financial penalties and/or permanent removal from Pop Warner.
- However, participants accompanied by their designated chaperones that are at least 21 years or older who are returning from organized team activities (including without limitation theme park excursions, group dinners, or the Pop Warner add-on events outside of their hotels shall be excused from such curfew but MUST be immediately escorted by such chaperones to their rooms upon returning to their hotels. To clarify, when at Partner Hotels, ALL participants MUST be in their rooms by 10:00 P.M. regardless of whether their competition has begun, is ongoing or is completed. Any players found outside their assigned rooms past 10:00 P.M. while they are still registered as a Pop Warner group shall be subject to disciplinary action along with their coaches, teams, and/or associations as stated above. Pop Warner National, Regional and Event Staff shall be conducting daily checks to ensure compliance.

XIII. In order to fairly and promptly address any behavior at or associated with the Pop Warner Super Bowl involving any and all violations of the General and Members Codes of Conduct, Pop Warner policy or rules' violations and/or behavior that resulted in harm or may result in probable harm to participants, volunteers, parents, spectators or other individuals, such aforementioned behavior shall be governed by the Disciplinary Review Board (DRB) as outlined in the DRB Policies. All Head Coaches and Association Presidents must read the DRB Policies and sign the attached Statement of Acceptance in order to participate in the Pop Warner Super Bowl. Copies of the DRB Policies are provided under separate cover. Forms requesting a hearing as well as a copy of the DRB process will be available upon request at the Volunteer Tent in Area B during the duration of the Super Bowl.

- As a condition of your team's participation in the Pop Warner Super Bowl, all participants, coaches, administrators and supporters agree to display good sportsmanship throughout the Super Bowl and related events or the entire team's eligibility and presence on site may be revoked without refund. Every Head Coach is required to read and sign the Pop Warner Coaches Code of Conduct at the Coaches meeting to ensure an understanding of what is acceptable conduct for all teams and supporters. Head Coaches are responsible for not only their own proper behavior, but also for the behavior of each member of their staff, their team and ALL of the team's supporters.
- The Head Coach and the Association President will be held accountable for proper conduct of coaches, parents and any other persons affiliated with the team. Head Coaches and Association Presidents must read and review the "Personal Responsibility at PWLS Events and Sportsmanship" memos contained in this packet with your entire team and organization.
- Players, coaches, administrators and parents or other supporters that violate these articles, rules and regulations and/or any Pop Warner or rules while in attendance will be subject to disciplinary action including but not limited to removal from the Mecklenburg County Sportsplex, Othro-Carolina Sportsplex and Partnering properties without refund, disqualification from the event, removal from the Pop Warner program and any applicable legal/criminal penalties.
- ALL teams must stay on a partnership property throughout the event to participate and REMAIN eligible for the Super Bowl – 3- night minimum stay will be enforced. Teams advancing to championship games must stay on property. (STAY TO PLAY supersedes the night minimum stay)

- XIV. Schedule—All teams are offered and committed to playing 2 games, Sun and Wed, Sat and Tues. All teams are guaranteed 2 games. All Championship games will be played on Fri & Sat Dec 12 & 13. Teams that lose either of their first two games will not play on Championship Fri or Sat. Teams that choose NOT to participate in a consolation game, thereby creating a forfeit, will be subject to penalties including but not limited to an automatic one-year suspension from Regional and National Championship/Super Bowl for their ENTIRE Association and/or League as well as potential suspensions/removal of the forfeiting team's entire coaching staff.
- XV. In the event of a tie, the ten yard-line overtime procedure will be utilized.
- XVI. In accordance with and in addition to the Revised Article 17 of the Pop Warner Rule Book, injured participants may NOT return to practice/performance without explicit approval from assigned medical personal including, but not limited to, Athletic Trainers and/or Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs).
- XVII. Videotaping Opponents Practice for scouting purposes is forbidden. Violators shall be subject to penalties as outlined herein.
- XVIII. Teams MUST complete and submit Media Forms by midnight on Mon Nov 26.
- XIX. To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all guests, please respect and adhere to all Mecklenburg County Sportsplex and ALL partnering venue rules while on respective properties. Please review the FAQs in the document for a detailed list.
- XX. XXI. The use of Drones is prohibited.
