#### Players and Parents,

Thank you for your interest in playing with the New Berlin Heat. We are very excited about this, and are looking forward to a fun, fastpitch filled year. It is important to recognize that this is NOT a recreational program, everyone does NOT make the team, and the focus on competition increases dramatically. The philosophy of the program is to give youth in New Berlin an opportunity to play fastpitch at an advanced level while preparing them to play at the High School level.

#### By signing below, I/We understand that (read carefully):

- There is a significant time commitment to your team and teammates.
- This is NOT a recreational program. There is no minimum playing time requirement!
- Most practices and games are mandatory.
- Softball comes <u>after school</u> a<u>cademic functions</u> (i.e. Band, Orchestra, Science Fair, etc.), major religious functions, and <u>major</u> family functions (vacations, grandma's 110<sup>th</sup> birthday party, etc.).
- After April 1<sup>st</sup>, Heat softball comes <u>before</u> all other non-academic activities (i.e. <u>soccer</u>, track, basketball, dances, etc.). <u>Players will be dropped for lack of commitment to the program.</u> Remember playing time is earned by skill and commitment, missing practices **will** affect playing time.
- Coaches may hold some practices in the off season (before April 1<sup>st</sup>). While these practices are not mandatory, every effort should be made to attend in order to avoid falling behind the other players (especially pitchers
- All families are required to help with concessions and Field Marshall at the Heat tournament in early June.
