## 2026 FAQ's

## When is registration?

Registration is open now and will close on March 7<sup>th</sup> 2026 for Spring. Please use the online portal to register. From the NPGFS home page click on the "register" button on the top right corner.



## What age group will my daughter be in?

Divisional placement is determined by age as of September 1st, 2025.

Instructional Division (tee-ball)	Age as of Sep 1, 2025
6U	4.5, 5 & 6 yrs old
Instructional Division (coach pitch)	Age as of Sep 1, 2025
8U	6, 7 & 8 yrs old
Fastpitch Division (player pitch)	Age as of Sep 1, 2025
10U	9 & 10 yrs old
12U	11 & 12 yrs old



## How much does it cost to register?

6U - \$60 8U - \$100 10U and 12U- \$115

There is a \$10 discount for 1st sibling, \$20 discount for 2nd sibling that will automatically be applied when you register.

Costs include uniform shirt and pants. The league has cleats available for 6U players while supplies last

#### When does the season start?

Coach outreach and practices: April 1st

Opening Day: April 18th

#### Where is the field?

We have use the fields at the bottom of Captain Stephen Olney Memorial Park, 180 Smithfield Rd, North Providence, RI 02904.

Games will be played at Stephen Olney Park, North Smithfield, Lincoln and Cumberland.

## Do we need to live in North Providence to play?

Players from North Providence and surrounding areas are welcome to join our organization.

What days and times will my daughter have practices and games?



During the Spring the season will usually start with two practices and one game per week. After the first few weeks players may have two games and one practice

Weekday practices and games typically have an arrival time of 5:30pm

The days of the week are largely based on coaching availability. The league tries to keep the practice/playing days consistent (example: every Mon, Weds, Sat.)

#### What is included with the uniform?

The uniform will be a t-shirt, softball pants and softball socks.

### Does my daughter need to try out?

No, a player does not need to try-out for recreation softball. All skills levels and abilities are welcome.

## How can I get involved in the league?

We appreciate volunteers of all age groups. You do not need to have to be a softball expert to help coach. All teams need extra hands to help set up equipment for drills, line the fields for games, keep the batting order in the dugout, etc.

Volunteers are needed to help run the snack bar, perform field maintenance, and to participate on the NPGFS Board.

Please indicate on the registration form if you are interested in coaching or volunteering.

Only coaches are allowed on fields during practices or games. All volunteers must obtain a valid BCI from USA Softball.
