General Game Rules

- Pledge of Allegiance to be said before first game of the day on each field.
- The home and visiting teams will be decided by a coin toss prior to the start of each game.
- 1 minute limit warm-up between innings
- New Pitcher 8 pitches
- Runners <u>must slide</u> on close plays. Umpires' judgment to call the runner out if the runner does not slide.
- Home team is the official scorekeeper and must turn in score to Marinette Youth Baseball representative/coach at the end of the game at their respective field.
- All teams <u>must</u> be at the ball field 60 minutes prior to the start of the game. If games get ahead of schedule, we will start games earlier.
- Home team will be the higher seed in single elimination brackets.
- ***9U-14U A team may bat their entire roster or bat only their lineup. An extra hitter (EH) is allowed and must be announced at the start of the game. If a team bats nine players (or 10 with EH), any starter may re-enter a game once, as long as he returns to his original batting position in the line-up. Batting order must not change during the game.
