E. Sports / Operations Report

- a. Softball- fall ball registration is open. 9 U girls won their championship!
- b. Rec Soccer- working on securing coaches; will have registration open soon. Changed from previous years from birth year to grade year. Thought it may reduce the number of requests for changes. Next steps, secure enough coaches and build teams. Start the week after Labor Day.
- c. Travel Soccer- teams just got on the field to start practicing. Lots of new volunteers to help organize administratively. Mention of some uniform shipping issues.
- d. Field Hockey – registration just closed, and numbers are strong. Using turf this year to support practice.
- e. Baseball – Spring season big impacts due to rain. Summer season went well. 10U went on to sectionals and won and advanced to states. Great run for 10U. District 28 had 5 state winners. Fall registration is open, will close soon and start after Labor Day.
- f. Hillcats
 - i. Registration is open
 - ii. Try outs are over
 - iii. Senior teams are going strong.
- g. Lightening Softball- going well, several teams' runners up for Spring. Try outs are complete. Kicking off season on 8/23.
- h. Lacrosse – no report.
- i. Track and Field- consider finding a new commissioner and consider a Spring season.
- j. Basketball- open registration in October.

- a. Field C scoreboard is complete. Plantings are being finalized by Celtic Root.
