## **Old Business:**

- **1. Monies still owed:** Corvallis (Retreat) \$20, East Lane (All Stars) \$200, Mid-Valley (All Stars) \$100, S. Salem (Retreat) \$20 and Sprague (Retreat) \$20
- **2. ASAP:** Must submit immediately (Little League as well as D7). Roster/registration cannot be uploaded yet as Little League International doesn't have 2017 upload available. **Leagues not submitted according to Little League Site:** Cascade, Corvallis, East Lane, Eugene, Keizer, Mid-Valley, Mount Angel, Parrish, South Salem, South Valley, Sprague, Tri-Cities.
- **3. Softball Meeting:** Almost every league was in attendance. Corvallis will have a softball program this year (33 girls signed up). There is a new President from West Valley that will be assisting.
- **4. Financial Statements:** Due 2.15.17. Also send a copy to Cari for D7 records. An extension can be filed if needed.
- **5. Charter:** There are still a few leagues without their Charter submitted. Cascade (Liz informed that she has received an email stating it has recently been submitted), Mount Angel, South Valley, and Tri-Cities.
- **6. Boundary Maps:** At the Regional Meeting for DA's, information was shared that another vendor was being secured and that maps should be available online in approximately 6 weeks (meaning that they should be up shortly). Tom stated that "Find My League" was having some issues as well.

- **7. Rule Updates:** Cari summarized the various rule updates available. Leslie will attach the summary to the email with the minutes of this meeting.
- **8. Combined Teams:** Because of time restrictions, combined teams **MUST** be in by **May 20, 2017.** They will not be done after this date.
- **9. Bat Rule:** Was brought up and clarified/discussed again.

## **New Business:**

- **1. Tournaments:** Several Tournaments were shared via email with League Presidents. Leslie will attach the flyers to the email with the minutes of this meeting.
  - **a.** One that does not have a flyer is the Crushers Tournament held at Cascade. It is Memorial Day Weekend 5.27, 28, 29.17. They are hoping to have teams for 10u, 12u and 50/70. Camping will be available. Cost is same as previous years. Contact Cascade Little League for more information.
- **2. Registrations:** Leagues gave updates on registration for this coming season:
  - **a. Corvallis:** Using Blue Sombrero (first year), softball is being reintroduced, while JBO is present, numbers are roughly the same as last year.
  - **b. Cascade:** Using own online registration system. Influx of younger kids this year. Older kids still flip between Little League and JBO.
  - **c. Parrish:** Using Blue Sombrero (second year) Numbers are down, but they are still taking late registration essentially through the end of this month for drafted teams and 3 weeks into March for non-drafted teams.
  - **d. Mid-Valley:** Using Blue Sombrero. Larger turnout this year. Many younger players registered.
  - **e. Keizer:** Half of number from last year registered this year. Baseball is up, softball is down.
  - **f. S. Salem:** Down quite a bit, about 140. Started registration earlier this year; evaluations are 2.25.17
- **3. State Tournaments:** If interested in hosting, please submit a note/email/letter to Cari letting her know. Charter and Safety plan must be in on time and approved.
  - a. Jr/Sr Softball
  - b. 9-11 Baseball
- **4. Player fee:** It was dropped to \$5 per player per league this year.
- **5. Volunteer Awards:** Jeff Pinkerton, Tom Bowman, and Paul McGrath were given Volunteer of the Year awards from District 7.
- **6. December 1, 2, 3 2017 State Conference:** This year it will be held at Eagle Crest (there may not be a D7 retreat in November). District urges for Boards to encourage attendance at the State Conference as discussions will be held for topics to be brought to World Congress for Little League which is in January 2018. Pencil in the date now.
