Old Business:

- **2. Background Checks:** Cari went over who still has outstanding fees owed.
- 3. Player Age Form and fees: Updated form/fees are due no later than May 20th, 2017.

- **5. Tournament Bracket general information: PLEASE NOTE THIS is** *INFORMATIONAL* **at best and is subject to change.** As an example, for the 2016 tournament season, the District was told by the leagues that there would be 60 teams participating in District tournaments. That number dwindled to 30 which impacted every division of tournament play requiring brackets to be redone numerous times (right up to and the start of the tournament being played). Please know that it is the intention to give All Star teams as many games as possible.
 - **a. Pool play** will be done with eight or more teams in most cases. Single pool play will be considered for divisions with 4 to 6 leagues participating.
 - i. Two to 4 teams out of pool play will play in a single elimination final.
 - **ii. Double elimination** will be used for everything else.
 - **b.** The DA has the final word on brackets and must be Little League approved.
- **6. June 18, 2017: Drop Dead Date** for tournament team(s) without penalty. If a league drops a team after this date a \$300 fee will be given.
- **7. All Star Team fee:** It is lowered to \$50 per team this year.
- **8. All Star Certification Map:** Please use the map(s) given on the D7 website.
- **9. Certification checklist and concussion information:** Leslie will send out to District presidents.
- **10.All Star Umpires:** Please send names and contact information of current league UIC and volunteer umpires to Duane and Brandon for All Star contact.
- **11.All Star baseball and softballs:** Cari will specify maker of balls to bring for certification. A dozen balls are expected to be brought to certification for each team entered for All Stars. It was requested by Paul that the softball balls be made of leather and not synthetic (baseball as well).
- **12.All Star books MUST BE PRE-CERTIFIED by District Representative prior to certification night.** Please contact your representative to make arrangements for this to happen.
- 13.Certification Night make sure that your umpires, managers and coaches know that they MUST attend the meeting on June 20th at 5:30 in Albany.

Other Business:

1. First Aid and CPR training: Tim addressed group – online training is available for up to 500 people free of charge for 501C3 organizations. National CPR Foundation will send coupon code after receiving request from organization. Organization needs to provide nonprofit status documentation and window of time for which the coupon will be good for.
