## Board Meeting 10/20/25

Shane Morrison began the October board meeting, delayed due to a cheer competition, with a roll call of members including Anna Mohamad, Alicia Swinney, Daniel Smith, Debralee Morrison, Teresa Mendez, Wendy Smith, Alicia Sanchez, and Albert Sandoval, and welcomed Vinny Grippo as a new attendee. Discussions included the last home game featuring a fully operational snack bar, with Albert Sandoval ensuring coaches' presence for field setup and Amiad Mohamad mentioning a 10U bake sale. Shane Morrison reminded the board about November meeting discussions on termed positions and the new background check requirement for all board members, tasking Anna Mohamad to collect position selections. Shane Morrison confirmed Vinny Grippo as the new treasurer, succeeding Albert Sandoval, and planned to post open board positions publicly, with Shane Morrison also committing to speaking with Erica about her continued involvement. Key topics included ensuring security during playoff games due to heightened tensions, coordinating equipment returns with Daniel Smith and Anna Mohamad, and clarifying the \$50 per player maximum for coaches' fund payouts for end-of-season parties, with Anna Mohamad also clarifying fundraising distribution. Amiad Mohamad's question regarding fundraising reimbursements was addressed, with Anna Mohamad, Debralee Morrison, and Teresa Mendez agreeing that reimbursements should be deducted before calculating the league's percentage, a decision unanimously supported by the board. Albert Sandoval reported on year-end financials, adding Vinny Grippo to the Chase account, and transferring the CFO email. Shane Morrison noted three checks, including a \$3,515.50 fundraiser deposit, needed to be deposited, and Albert Sandoval confirmed plans to pay outstanding bills, including a \$10,000 check to Fallbrook Union High School. Amjad Mohamad requested payment for USA Football. Diamond, and Huddle invoices, and Daniel Smith informed the board about a pending invoice from Rebel for replacement uniforms. Wendy Smith reported on the successful completion of Little Scholars documentation and expressed a desire to train someone for the role. Alicia Swinney provided an update on the local cheer competition, with four teams qualifying for regionals. Anna Mohamad requested the first-place banner from West Coast, and Teresa Mendez suggested holding raffles at the upcoming home game, using donated gift cards and items. Anna Mohamad inquired about an end-of-season league event, with Shane Morrison suggesting a "costume fall ball" in November and proposing to establish an event coordinator board position for future event planning.
