Selma All-Star Weekend Tournament

- All tournaments will follow Little League rules for each division unless otherwise noted in the tournament rules. Teams do not have to be "sanctioned" Little League to participate.
- 2. Tournaments are for recreational all-star teams only.
- 3. Tournaments will consist of pool play followed by a single elimination tournament.

 Pool Play Format:
 - a. Each team will play at least 2 games of pool play (weather permitting)
 - b. Pool play games may end in a tie if time has expired and/or all innings have been completed.
 - c. Home team is determined by a coin toss

Bracket Play:

- d. After pool play is complete, teams will be seeded and placed into a bracket
- e. Seeding will be based on the following:
 - i. Win/Loss record
 - ii. Head to Head (if applicable)
 - iii. Runs Allowed
 - iv. Run Differential
 - v. Runs Scored
- vi. Coin toss
- f. Bracket games cannot end in a tie after time has expired and/or all innings have been completed. The "California Tie Breaker Rule" will be used to determine a winner.
 - i. California Tie Breaker Rule- Each team will start the inning with one out and put the last batter out on second base and play out the rest of the inning. This happens until the tie is broken and the game is complete.
 - g. Higher seed will choose whether to be home or visitor team
- 4. All teams are guaranteed a minimum of 3 games.
- 5. Championship rings will be awarded to the first place team.
- 6. Tournament schedule is subject to change due to weather. In the event the tournament must be shortened, teams that only play 1 game will have 50% of the

entry fee returned. All teams that play at least 2 games or more will not receive any money back.

- 7. There is no entry fee for spectators. Concessions will be available throughout the tournament.
- 8. All fees must be paid in full at least 48 hours before the first game of the tournament. Payment can be made in the form of a check, cash, money order, or credit card. There is a \$40 returned check fee.
- 9. No infield warm-ups prior to the game on any of the infields
- 10. No soft toss allowed on any permanent structure or fences at the parks
- 11. No pets, bikes, skateboards, etc are allowed on the grounds. We are a smoke-free facility.
- 12. The home team will be the official book. The visitor team will operate the scoreboard.
- 13. All coaches are responsible to clean the dugouts out after each game.
- 14. Unsportsmanlike conduct by any player, coach, or spectator will not be tolerated and will be removed from the game/premises. All ejections are for the remainder of the tournament.
- 15. Coaches must have a copy of each player's birth certificate on hand.
- 16. All players should be in complete, matching uniform. No metal spikes. Coaches do not have to be in uniform but should be identifiable with their team. (Team shirt is fine.)
- 17. Run rule will be 6 runs an inning for all innings. A game consists of 6 innings. A complete game is 3 ½ innings with the home team ahead. Run rule would be 7 runs after 5 innings, 13 runs after 4 innings.
- 18. No inning shall start after an hour and twenty-five minutes from the start time of the game in pool play. No inning shall start after an hour and forty-five minutes for bracket play. Championship games will not have a time limit.
- 19. Baseball Pitching Rule: A pitcher can pitch a maximum of 6 innings per day and a maximum of 7 innings total for the entire tournament. One pitch in an inning constitutes a full inning.
- 20. 12U will play by modified high school rules of 50 foot pitching mound and 70 foot base paths. 10U will play by modified high school rules of 46 foot pitching mound and 65 foot base paths. 8U will use GNBL rules.
- 21. Parking is available along the outfield of diamonds and between the concession stand and church on Friday and Saturday. On Sunday, the parking lot between the church and concession stand is not available until 12:30PM.
- 22. In the event of a delay, cancellation, communication will be sent out via text from the tournament director. If you need to get a hold of the tournament director, call Kim at 765-730-0705.
- 23. Tournament directors may make adjustments to the time limit due to weather or other issues.
