- J. 3000/ April –May targeted about 10K, we received 30% once program started every two weeks he would deposit money directly in to the account. Part of the money to program books –needed to give them the info for the program books, they would then print with vendors and info only have ONE sponsor for the book. Knowing that we didn't order the books as we get 30% regardless cost of books come from them.

Fred Parke/Safety Officer - Equipment Manager

- A. 10 headbands left
- B. We are loaning equip need to make sure all equip is coming back and brought to practice
- C. Injuries DOWN as a whole this year
- D. Trainer on sidelines has been helpful
- E. Concussions as a whole are down 1 so far this year --- helpful factor noted -everyone is wearing knee pads
- F. Injury reports coaches must turn in forms by Friday following game incidents

- B. We will all be there for STEPS Red Ribbon Rally

Jerry Beaudoin/Tackle Commissioner

- A. Take note of game time changes moved by 30 minutes
- B. Next 2 weeks we did half hour and 3rd week we did hour

- C. We understand lots of complaints on times trying to determine reason for the delayed times *Notes: Always had flag on lower field FLAG had two hours, two games 188 score between two games you add up 2 ½ hours minimum
- D. We are getting a lot of pressure and feed back about sidelines
- E. CODE OF CONDUCT will be announced before games, hold parents accountable (We are here for the kids but the parents need to get a hold of themselves)
- F. Referee Issue: Saturday flag parent approached ref after the game and we had an incident in the Steeler Lions game earlier this season and Lions Cowboys most recently (in the lions game there were 4 attempts to go the referee multiple times.) We are in a situation we have tried going with different refs in the past bigger disaster however the current talent pool has shrunk. We need to hold referees accountable by our standards and those of the Referee Code of Conduct.
- G. Flag Game conflict aggressive behavior from Flag Dolphin player, referees did not eject flag players for continued aggressive behavior
- H. Southington Lions vs. West Hartford Cowboys conflict aggressive behavior by West Hartford player after whistle was blown. Referee flew a flag and gave 15-yard penalty against West Hartford. Coach from Southington had warned referee of the behavior. Southington coach and West Hartford coach began verbal altercation. Referee asked Southington coach to 'cool off' referees did not have control of the field. No players or coaches were ejected from this game.

Andy Pettola/Vice President

- Introduced Ted Mancini President of WHYFL, he saw the video (of the Lions vs. Cowboys) for the first time tonight.
- Ted Mancini listening to the referees, part of the problem with inner town games, referees are NOT taking control of the game late hit no flag, then when flag is thrown everyone gets mad. Will speak to WH referees to see if they can do our Saturday games. (We will still need Friday referees.) Main objective, protect our children so they can have a safe and fair game. We will now have 4 referees at the Tackle C level games.
