

Spring Coed Flag Football FAQs

Registration

Registration is available at LHYSL.org. (Go to “Flag Football Registration” on the top row of home page).

When is the registration deadline?

Spring Deadline -- March 21ST

Is the Flag Football camp coed?

Yes! As most of our programs are, the Flag Football camp is open to boys and girls.

What are the Divisions of Play?

Divisions: Players will be placed in the division for their current grade level. Some divisions may have multiple teams and participants may be assigned up to down to a specific division based on size and skill.

Pee Wee: 3,4,5 year old (Pre-K & K)

Minis: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grades

Juniors: 4th, 5th, and 6th grades

What is registration cost?

\$65 for Pee Wee \$75 for Minis – Juniors

- Game shirts will be provided by the league Belts and Flags will be provided by the league.

What do I provide for my child that isn't covered in registration cost?

- Mouth piece/guard
- Black shorts without pockets
- Cleats (football or soccer) NO BASEBALL CLEATS
- Water for hydration during practice & game (concessions may be offered)

What kind of playing time can my child expect?

Rules are in place to promote equal playing time regardless of skillset or experience. This camp will focus on teaching fundamentals of football (catching, passing, lineups, defense, etc).

When will practices & games occur?

Practices will be held Sunday evenings prior to their scheduled games. Schedule to come soon.

Where are the practices and games held?

Craig Field (located behind North Elementary)

How will players be placed on teams?

Players will be placed into divisions based on current age/grade.

Evaluations and Combine will be held March 20th.

Practices/Games Overview

All practices and games will be Sunday evenings (after 4pm). Exact times TBD.

Weeks 1 and 2 practices will be 2 hours long (no game).

For the Pre-K/K division, practices will be 60 minutes followed by a 30-minute game.

For Mini (1st/2nd/3rd grade) division, practices will be 60 minutes followed by a 40-minute game.

For Junior (4th, 5th, 6th) division, practices will be 60 minutes followed by a 50-minute game.

Coaches/Officials/Referees

The LH Varsity/JV Football players will be participating as Coaches/Referees during practice and game play. Our LHYSL tackle football coaches will also be assisting.
