

- Hosted Indoor Opening Ceremony, SDLL Day at Duke Baseball, SDLL Day at Durham Bulls, Moe's SDLL Days, SDLL at PDQ & PDQ at the Park
- Partnered w/sponsor NCCPT to offer speed, strength & flexibility clinics 2x per year

Highlights

- Conducted first indoor evaluation
- 266/325 (82%) players received comprehensive post-season player evaluation from their Team Manager and/or Assistant Coach
- No assistants prior to the draft
- Implemented online training tools for Tee Ball

Next Steps

- Work with the Safety Officer to possibly add Medical Waiver to online registration
- Reimplement LLI rule no more than 8 league age 12 players on each Majors team (*estimated 40-50* League Age 12 players 2019)
- Develop a Player Substitution Coordinator role
- Find a new sock vendor or eliminate socks from provided uniform
- Continue to support Duke Baseball
- Continue with Uniform Task Group and Transition Uniform Coordinator role in 2019

Facilities Committee - Safety

Background Check Rule

Little League Baseball and Softball requires each league to sign an agreement on the league charter application that commits the league to comply with Regulation I[b][c][8][9]. Background checks are to be completed annually for following volunteers: (a) BOD, (b) Coaches, (c) Umpires, (d) Practice Coaches/Volunteers, (e) Team Parents, and (f) anyone that has repetitive access to the players.

2018 Background Checks

- •94% rate, continues to trend upward w/league goal 100% (100% rate for coaches, BOD members & other volunteers w/direct player contact achieved in 2018)
- Successfully added umpires to the process
- Successfully processing all background check information online & thru new LLI vendor
- LLI covers fees for first 125, expect in future SDLL to have budget item for background check as league needs are expected to exceed this limit

Facilities Committee - Safety

2018 Pitching

- Participated in Duke Ortho Arm Study in Majors Division w/20+ players
- No team penalized for untimely reporting of pitch count
- Continue stress of timely pitch count reporting
- Players playing on other non-SDLL team, stress importance to parents to inform their coach of their player's pitch count numbers
- Consider drafting document for Parents regarding pitch counts, arm care & recovery


2018 Injuries

- Submittal of safety plan and insurance renewal
- Injuries reported increased 2017 to 2018, but may be impacted by better reporting practices
- Majority of injury incidents occurring during games & being struck by ball leading cause




Incident Reports by Age


Highlights



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
Top 12 Schedule General & Repeated Comments

- 1. High remarks for schedule on website, difficult task
- 2. Loved Friday nights at the Park (double headers)
- 3. Disliked EOST single elimination, communication a surprise
- 4. Disliked arrivals prior to 6P
- 5. Games w/7:30 start time too late
- 6. All weeknights all games hard stop 1.5 hours
- 7. Set a required number of T-Ball Games
- 8. Set days of week of division/team play
- 9. Alternate better, so teams do not play each other repeatedly back-to-back or always early start time (before 9A starts) or late start time (7:30)
- 10. Never schedule more than 12 games, season runs too long too many practices/games
- 11. More practices/games: reschedule cancelled practices & games, schedule more indoor for rainouts, 5 practices before start, practices over holidays, 3 events (1P/2G) a week
- 12. Try to schedule less when cold or later during day & earlier in evening

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For the Majors Division, SDLL scheduled double-headers on Friday night at 5:45P and 7:30P. How do you feel about the Friday night double-header this season?



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Value for Registration Fee




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
