

## Brunswick Jr. Railroader's CODE OF ETHICS

Brunswick Junior Railroader's Players, Parents, Family, Friends, and other spectators have, by example of behavior, a great impact on the team players. Accordingly, the following "Code of Ethics" will be enforced:

- All parents <u>WILL stay off of the practice field</u>. This may cause distraction among the players and loss of concentration.
- No Profanity of any kind will be tolerated by players, parents or BJR Staff. This will result in your removal from the playing fields and spectator areas. Players using profanity will be dealt with immediately by coaching staff.
- We will not tolerate rude or disorderly parents or spectators. This may cause the dismissal of your child from the team. Remember all criticisms should be constructive.
- It is the Parent's responsibility to ensure that each player arrive at all practices and games on time and ready to participate.
- It is the Parent's responsibility to contact the Head Coach of your child's team if they are unable to attend a practice or game. Please notify as soon as possible, preferably the day before.
- Never use any physical means against spectators, players, officials or coaches.
- <u>NO Alcohol, Smoking or Any Other Lighted Tobacco Products</u> should be used near or on the playing fields. BJR will not tolerate the consumption or significant signs of impairment as a result of alcoholic beverages/use at our youth sporting events. Anyone found to be in violation of this will be asked to leave the Sports Complex immediately for a 1<sup>st</sup> Offense, the remainder of the season for a 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense and a Lifetime Ban for a 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense. There is no timeframe associated with these violations and shall carry over from year to year.
- Accept decisions of officials as being fair and called to the best ability of the official. *Never go on the field to dispute a call.* This can result in a forfeiture of the game for our teams.
- Accept decisions of the coaching staff as final. *They coach the team*.
- **Do not unduly criticize players in front of spectators or other players**. Criticisms should be constructive in nature.
- There is no favoritism. At the same time, however, there is a "NO MUST PLAY EQUAL TIME RULE". Players are placed in positions at the Coach's discretion based on the coaching staff's evaluation of the player's skills and needs of the team.
