- YTD expenses of \$170K vs. \$151K in prior year
- Current cash of \$44K vs. \$22K in prior year

7. VP's Report (Hannah Rees)

- Season-to-date Profit of ~\$11K has been able to cover ref fees.
- Looking at alternate payment services.
- Considering offering sponsorships in 2026 to cover ref fees for each game.
- Key club may help with the snack stand next year.

- Snack stand may have to close at 6pm on 10/11/25 if additional volunteers aren't secured to cover the 6pm game.
- Pennridge High School Homecoming parade is on 10/17/25. Greenjackets are invited to participate in the parade. Pink out theme.
- Snap 20% back plus sponsorship which varies based on number of years committed.

8. Football Commissioner's Report (Keith Fox)

9. Cheerleading Commissioner's Report (Hannah Rees on behalf of Amanda Wolf)

- Junior peewee gift card basket fundraiser generated a \$3k profit.
