

PARENTS, COACHES AND PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR ST. CHARLES STORM BASKETBALL

St. Charles Basketball Organization PARENT/PLAYER Conduct Agreement

I, the parent of the registrant/registered player recognize my responsibility to the welfare of all of the participants in the St. Charles Basketball Organization program and agree to the following:

- I will respect the coach even when I do not agree with him/her.
- I will respect the parents and players of the opposing team regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will not make negative comments at referees, players or other parents.
- I will not fight with or bully my/my child's teammates or opponents.
- If I feel my child's well-being is at risk, I will ask the coach to take them out of the game immediately.
- I will help my child learn the rules and skills of basketball.
- I will let the coaches know if my child cannot attend a practice or game.
- I will not allow my children to roam the buildings unattended.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the registered coaches for the team.
- I will respect the officials and coaches for their authority during games and practices; I will never question, discuss or confront coaches at the gym, but will allow 24 hours after the incident or situation before speaking with the coach.
- I will remember that sports are an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I will behave in an appropriate manner in accordance with the above and understand if I do not, disciplinary actions may take place.

St. Charles Basketball Organization COACH Conduct Agreement

I, the coach of a team, recognize my responsibility to the welfare of all the participants in the St. Charles Basketball Organization program and agree to the following:

- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range of emotional and physical development for the same age group.
- I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.
- I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
- I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players.
- I will provide a sports environment for my team that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol; and I will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will be knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that I coach, and I will teach these rules to my players.
- I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills I teach.
- I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for the children and not the adults.
- I will behave in an appropriate manner in accordance with the above and understand if I do not, disciplinary actions may take place.

Decisions regarding disciplinary action will be determined by a vote of the board of directors. The board reserves the right to take any disciplinary action it deems necessary and may include the following: Suspension from attending one game; suspension from attending two games; permanent suspension.
