II. Old Business

III. New Business

February Frenzy Planning- updates....

Todd provided feedback on number of teams registered. 33 teams currently registered. Discussion regarding 8th graders choose shirt design. Pre-orders for teams in our tournament. Vendors are lined up the same as last year. Signature sponsor will hopefully be King Orthodontics. Scott is looking into getting UPMC as a sponsor.

Trophys versus Tshirts – Tshirts will be the choice with Champion on the sleeve. Also discussing ordering Medals for 2/3rd. Concern about tshirt sizing but believe adult sizes would be best choice. Todd will send an update to the schools regarding the fact that we are changing to shirts for Champions. Also focusing on 8/6 team brackets.

Referees for the tournament will be bidded out by the board. Denise will be sending emails to all parties interested to ref the tourney. Denise Bohinski will be responsible for covering of for 85 games to

referee. She will be asking for a per game cost from each organization how they prefer to be paid for the tournament.

3. Treasurer's Report – Approval of Budget. Lori brought an updated version of the budget and we covered off on adjusted donations to the high school boosters.
