Coach & Player Requests

There are **no coach and/or player requests** for the Spring season. Most divisions are split into American and National leagues, and **assessments determine placement**.

Majors & Seniors Divisions

- Majors and Seniors teams are created via a **draft**
- Some players who played up in Fall may not be drafted up in Spring
- Age-eligible players not drafted will be placed in **Minors or Juniors**
- Players drafted into Majors or Seniors in **Spring 2025** remain on their teams until they age out

Spring Camps and Assessments:

Specific groups and times will be emailed to players in early February. **2025 drafted majors and seniors' players will not attend assessments or camps as they have already been drafted.**
