

## **NNPRT Athletics Coach Code of Ethics**

## **AS A VOLUNTEER COACH, I WILL:**

- 1. Remember the focus in recreation play is placed on fun and learning.
- 2. Consider it a privilege to coach children.
- 3. Remember that I am a youth coach and that the game is for children and not adults.
- 4. Use positive coaching methods to make the experience enjoyable, increase self-esteem, and develop an appreciation for the sport.
- 5. Place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- 6. Direct only constructive comments and/or criticism relative to players' game performance.
- 7. Remember to treat each player as an individual and not place blame for overall team performance on any one participant.
- 8. Provide a safe playing situation for all players on the team I coach.
- 9. Ensure I know the rules of each sport I coach and teach these rules to my players.
- 10. Lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players and parents.
- 11. Promote sportsmanship and follow the sports rules with no violation of them in an effort to win.
- 12. Not abuse, threaten, or demean (physical, verbally or mentally) any player, parent, coach, or official.
- 13. Not use foul and abusive language at any time.
- 14. Control the emotions, egos, frustrations, and displays of anger of myself and my players.
- 15. Not use alcohol, tobacco or drug related products while actively involved in NNPRT activities or on city property at any time.
- 16. Make sure that every team parent and player has read and understands the NNPRT Codes of Conduct.
