UNIFORM CLEANING & DRYING INSTRUCTIONS

Following these instructions will keep your apparel clean and in good shape.

If not cared for properly, your garments could fade, shrink, stiffen and/or crack/wrinkle.

PRE-TREATING

- Pre-treat heavily soiled garments with solvents without bleach
- Soak blood stains in cold water before washing

WASHING

- Turn garments inside out to preserve ink
- · Wash in cold water after each use
- Use oxygen based laundry booster
- High water levels minimize mechanical action on uniforms
- Remove garments immediately from machine after washing

DRYING

- Hang dry whenever possible!
- If you must use a dryer, choose a low setting like damp dry or air dry
- Do not overload the dryer as it will cause ink printed uniforms to stick together
- Do not use high heat setting as this could cause shrinking, cracking of ink or wrinkling of twill
- Remove garments immediately from machine after drying

STORING

 Store in a dark, cool and dry area protected from sunlight and fluorescent lighting
