Schedule of Events

Friday, June 27

1-3pm Team check-in - Team managers are required to report to the Princess Anne Little League Complex with the following: tournament affidavit, with approved tournament player verification, signed affidavit map, and medical releases.

5pm Opening Ceremonies - Teams will be lined up and introduced on the main tournament field, and a brief Opening Ceremony will take place. A challenger game will be held directly after opening Ceremony. Tournament players are requested to be buddies for the challenger players.

6pm: Pre-Tournament Meeting - All tournament officials, managers, and coaches are required to attend. Coin flips will be held to determine home teams for all pool play games.

Saturday, June 28 – Games begin at 10am.

All activities will take place at the Princess Anne Little League complex (4141 Dam Neck Road Virginia Beach, Virginia 23456).

Umpire Information

Approved volunteer umpires will be used for this tournament. Every effort will be made to ensure no umpire will officiate a game in which his or her District is involved, however due to the availability of umpires this may not be possible.

Registration

Team check-in will take place on Friday, June 27 from 1-3pm. Team managers are required to report to the Princess Anne Little League Complex with the following: tournament affidavit with approved player verification, signed affidavit map, and medical releases.

Opening Ceremonies

Opening Ceremonies will take place on Friday, June 27 at 5pm at the Princess Anne Little League Complex. Teams will be lined up and introduced on the main tournament field (Field #1), and a brief Opening Ceremony will take place. A challenger game will be held directly after opening Ceremony. Tournament players are requested to be buddies for the challenger players.

Managers, Coaches and Umpires Meeting

A Pre-Tournament Meeting will be held on Friday, June 27 at 6pm at the Princess Anne Little League Complex. All tournament officials, umpires, managers, and coaches are required to attend.

Playing and Practice Fields

All tournament games will be played at the Princess Anne Little League complex (4141 Dam Neck Road Virginia Beach, Virginia 23456). There is a concession stand and restrooms. Bleacher seating is available, but feel free to bring lawn chairs. No practice will be held on the tournament fields. There are other fields on the complex available for practice; please do not call in advance; practice fields will be discussed at Friday's Pre-Tournament Meeting. In the event of rain, alternate fields may be used

Admission/Parking Fees

There is no admission fee charged to attend Tournament games. Parking at the Princess Anne Little League Complex is free.

Spectator Policies and Procedures

Bleacher seating is available, but feel free to bring lawn chairs.

NO noise makers of any kind may be used.

Music will NOT be permitted except that provided by the press box.

Tobacco and alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted.

No equipment associated with parental streaming of games may be affixed to any location on the playing facility including light stanchions and fencing. If a parent wishes to stream a game, it must be viewed through a personal social media account for private use only and may not be on the open Internet.

Game Procedures/Guidelines

Teams must report to the Princess Anne Little League complex at least one hour before scheduled game time.

Home and visitor for all pool play games will be conducted by coin flip at the Pre-Tournament Meeting. Home and visitor for all single elimination finals games will be determined by coin flip at the field when teams arrive. The home team will occupy the first base dugout and the visiting team will occupy the third base dugout.

All 2025 Little League International Tournament Rules for Intermediate Baseball will be used throughout the tournament, without exception.

Concession and Vendor Information

The Princess Anne Little League Concession Stand will be open and serving various food and drink items throughout the tournament. Cash and credit/debit cards are acceptable forms of payment.

There will also be a pin sales area set up – all proceeds from the sale of pins go to offset the expenses of annual Jake Hardison Memorial Challenger Jamboree.

Additional vendors may be added before the start of the tournament.

Internet Information

Our District 8 website (www.va8ll.org) and Facebook page (www.facebook.com/va8ll) will post score and schedule updates during the tournament. Tournament games WILL NOT be livestreamed.

Team Equipment

The tournament field is artificial turf, only Tennis shoes or Rubber cleats will be allowed (No Metal Cleats)

Each team is responsible for providing its own equipment approved for Little League Baseball play. If the need arises, Princess Anne Little League may be able to loan equipment to a team in case of an emergency.
