- May Evaluations
 - o Current process: One higher-level team and remaining players distributed evenly
 - Method: Players are rostered primarily by the following factors:
 - By the evaluation score earned
 - Observed game play (known abilities) of individual players
 - Not required or necessary, but feedback from other board members and/or coaches may be requested.
 - o Result: The Rostering Committee will assemble the highest player evaluation scores for a higher-level team using the methods identified above. That team will play in a more competitive division at the PA West Travel level in that age group. Remaining players will be rostered equitably on to other teams within that age group which will play in a lower division (D6). This will be done by utilizing player evaluation scores and a player's team and coach history. The Rostering Committee will attempt to the best extent possible to keep teams and coaches together season to season after the higher-level team has been rostered. Should this be done correctly when moving from U8 to U10, there should be little movement from season to season. The higher-level team may also stay together if the same group of players scores are highest again following the next player evaluation session, the next Spring season. Should there be a significant change in a player's skills in any given season, the Rostering Committee reserves the right to move this player to the higher-level team at the start of any new season. Choosing this

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option does not mean that a higher-level team is guaranteed every season, and is dependent registration numbers in an age group. Those choosing not to participate in evaluations will be placed on teams according to how the rostering committee sees fit per the registration numbers. Should a player not want to be moved to the higher-level team, they will be rostered like the rest of the remaining players. Players who are playing both seasons will take priority for the higher-level team.

- Board voted YES by all in attendance to have Steve, the Player Technical Director and his associates per his choosing conduct the evaluations.
- Board voted YES by all in attendance to also have one Head Coach per team OR one Assistant Coach per team help conduct evaluations. Either Head Coach OR Assistant Coach, not both. And that person needs to be able to devote their time for each day/full hours scheduled of the evaluation process. Cannot have Head Coach assigned one day and then send Assistant Coach as replacement for next day.
