PINE BUSH LITTLE LEAGUE LIGHTNING SAFETY GUIDELINES

The Board member on duty (BOD) will be responsible for implementing the Lightning Safety Protocols set forth in these guidelines. In his /her absence, the responsibility will lie with another Board member at the field and/or the umpire in chief.

- If EITHER of the conditions below exist, ALL games will be stopped:
 - a. IF LIGHTNING IS OBSERVED
 - b. IF THUNDER IS HEARD
- ALL games will be resumed <u>after 30 minutes</u> have elapsed since the time of last lightning activity.
- All players, coaches and spectators should move to a safe area immediately once games
 are stopped. NOTE: Small outdoor buildings, including dugouts, rain shelters, sheds,
 etc., ARE NOT SAFE. Players and parents should be advised NOT to leave the fields
 UNTIL the games are called.
- The umpire in chief will consult with the BOD to determine when play can resume, depending on field conditions, weather reports, etc.
