- IRS reinstating 501c3 ~3-4 months until we get non-profit status back
 - Cannot file last years taxes until we regain non-profit status
 - Extension filed to extend our filing to August
 - Kiley asked if we can apply for grants if we do not have our 501c3 status
- Kris Mall – nothing additional
- Kylie Topeka:
 - Overview of registration numbers and rosters
 - Rosters for all divisions finalized by end of this week to complete uniform orders

 - Need to determine if continue as winter workout or allow teams to reserve

 - 1 x 7 yr old & 1 x 10 yr old asking to register *****board votes to allow
 - T-ball evaluations this week for anyone thinking of going to coach pitch at OGS
 - Vote on Constitution & By-laws – approved for Brandon and Jen to upload to LL Data Center
 - Contract for Scott Johnson still with Jen
 - Another from softball
 - Both want to review the contract prior to finalizing 2 x tournaments
 - Get to Scott by end-of-week
 - Reschedule field work day
 - Scott Johnson: Signature Engraving company for trophies and engraving and awards
 - Does not charge per character

- BRANDON is getting both bids
 - Needs to include C field and general area
- Justin Gray:
 - Pick-up baseballs last week
 - Equipment pick-up date will likely be 29MAR
 - Josh Hull requested to have catching gear for his team prior to equipment pick-up date
 - Determined yes coordinate with Justin
- Debbie Battista:
 - Launch of the gear
 - We are heading the cash-bingo concession stand
 - Need to determine what we want to provide
- Mike Vogt made motion to open the floor to public comment before the review of new business – YES
- PUBLIC COMMENT:
 - How do we determine where the new registrations fall in team selection
 - Answer by Kurtis that we need to do to evaluate and then adjust
 - Led to further discussion on how we figure out who to invite to the evaluation
 - Josh Hull brought up how this eval transfers to the minors to majors and coach pitch to minors
 - It was not done on those kids moving up from minors to majors which effected decisions through the coach pitch level
 - Led to a continuing discussion on conducting evaluations every year for every team
 - Does the keeper system work – larger questions
 - Have a redraft every year
 - Kurt Troxell
 - Sent an email 10-days ago to the board
 - Drafted based on keeper system
 - Concerns about “limbo-kids”
 - 1/3 of kids every year will fall into this category
 - Kurtis Strouse response
 - Based on no changes at the majors level
 - Parking along the T-ball field (A-field fence)
 - Keep it on the meeting minutes as we get closer to the season opener
 - Kurtis asking for input from the coaches on a redraft of both the minors and majors
 - Structure would be keeping assistant coaches and then redrafting teams beyond that
 - Do the coaches agree on the redraft?
 - Does this get us to 3 equal teams at the minor league level
 - Josh suggested a head coach gets 1 assistant coach and then drafts the entire team from there **** put on the minutes before next year
 - Overall, the league needs to have a vote on removing the keeper system and go to a yearly full draft for all divisions
 - Motion to have a re-draft to have a meeting with available board members and minor league coaches utilizing “keeper” of head coach and 2 assistant coach kids

 - Include evaluation
- Kurtis made a motion to redraft minors division starting with assistant coaches (3) total and then full redraft after that – MOTION passed 6 (Y) with 3 (N)
 - Mike Vogt will reach out to coaches and pertinent members of the board for a date to conduct a redraft
- Kurtis Strouse:
 - Talking coach-pitch on how we developed our teams
 - Brought up the issue of Kurtis bringing his child up from t-ball to finalize his roster
 - Mike Goddisaurt discussed communication of how the decisions were made and how ages, evaluations, and movements are done
 - Continued conversation on how the ages dilute coach pitch and created the A/B system
 - Motion to hold t-ball evaluations on 03MAR was voted on and passed
