Hello PWLL Families,

We are writing to give everyone an update on the efforts of the Board of Directors to plan for a 2020 season in these unprecedented times. PWLL continues to follow State and City regulations with respect to the suspension of all baseball activities, while monitoring health/safety guidelines from the CDC, Little League, and Government/Health Officials as we prepare to (hopefully) return to playing baseball this Summer.

Soon after the COVID-19 pandemic caused all little league activities to shut down, PWLL formed a subcommittee consisting of board members, coaches, parents, and other volunteers to help the league navigate these uncharted waters and start developing a safety plan for when we return to play. That subcommittee has been meeting virtually on a regular basis to review current regulations and guidelines released by various regulatory organizations and government officials. The subcommittee is incorporating those regulations and guidelines into PWLL's return to play safety plan, which remains a work in progress as new information/guidance is released.

As with all youth sport organizations, player safety is the number 1 priority of PWLL. Everything we do has that premise as it's foundation. As the month of June begins, the PWLL subcommittee and the full Board of Directors will continue to work on PWLL's plan for returning to playing baseball.

To help us with that planning, we are asking everyone to please respond to the survey you received about your interest in playing baseball this Summer in the event PWLL is cleared to do so. While we realize your interest may change in the upcoming weeks, we are trying our best to formulate schedules for all five divisions, which is a herculean task in the best of times. In order to do that, we first need to know how many teams we will have in each division if we are able to have a season. Your response to the survey will help us gauge interest in each division as we enter the month of June and hopefully move closer to playing baseball. The survey for our Majors, Triple A, and Double A divisions was sent out by the manager of each team in these divisions. The survey for Coach Pitch and Tee Ball was sent out by the division coordinators for these divisions.

We will continue to keep our league updated as information is received in the upcoming weeks from Government/Health officials as to the prospect of Summer baseball.
