- a. Approve minutes from previous meetings - Mike Motioned, Shalee Second. Motion approved.
- b. Review agenda

1. Opening Day - **Shalee** - Arrive around 8am. Maybe help Tim earlier.
 - a. Ceremony
 - i. Volunteers - One volunteer for 9:30 to 11:30 at the merch table. Boy Scouts are coming this year for the pledge of allegiance. Caius and Desiree will set up his national anthem "stage".
 - b. First Pitch - Colin and Lando will catch and pitch.
 - c. Snack Shack/Merch - Let people know the snack shack will open before ceremonies start.
 - i. Volunteers Needed - fill in the spots you can do. We know that everyone will be there but we need bodies.

 - b. QH Shed Hinges - better hinges and better screws for the hinges. Thanks to Jared and Brendan for fixing the door.
 - c. HS Shed
 - i. Chalkers - highlands and quail 20 bags or so. Need to distribute at the high school too.
 - ii. Will need chalk before the end of the season.
 - d. AAA Fence - Friday night to possibly set it up for opening day.
 - e. The double bases from the original order, we are stuck with. We did get a discount on the second round of the bottoms. Pegs have been cut for the first base pegs.

6. Treasurer Report - **Desiree**

7. UIC Report - **Erik**
 - a. Umpire Clinic - joined AAA practice for the plate umpire clinic. Joined an AA practice for bases. App for scheduling is working very well. Everyone can access the app themselves. Get a list of the youth vs adults to make sure we have the background check. Erik will keep the record for tracking.
 - b. Join the app and umpire a game, it's fun!

8. Uniforms - **Matt**
 - a. Hats with Velcro are unpopular. Next year we should look at doing AA- 50/70 thru Salina for a more custom experience.
 - b. The major's White Sox team uniforms were not what the manager had wanted at all. Originally he wanted the black uniforms, but got white with the old sox font across the chest. The hats did not match the uniform and were more of the modern sox logo and were black. Initially we were told that changing the uniforms after the deposit had been

made was not possible, even though the conversation took place one day after the deposit was made. On March 9th, the manager visited sport-about and was told they could remake the black uniforms for \$35 each. This ended up being less expensive than ordering all new snap back hats. Having the uniforms match for a majors team was important for the league and the \$385 invoice was approved by Adam.
